ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT, 1984

THE ABERDEEN CITY COUNCIL (OFF-STREET CAR PARKS, ABERDEEN) ORDER
2017

Aberdeen City Council, in exercise of its powers under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as "the 1984 Act"), and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Constable of Police Scotland in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act, and having complied with the requirements of The Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Procedure) (Scotland) Regulations 2002, hereby makes the following order:-

Citation

- (1) This order may be cited as "The Aberdeen City Council (Off-Street Car Parks, Aberdeen) Order 2017" and shall come into operation on 9 February 2017.

- (2) Definitions in relation to subsequent Articles

In the following Articles hereto, except where the context otherwise requires, the following expressions shall have the meanings hereby assigned to them:-

"Aberdeen City Council Staff Parking Permit" means a permit issued by Aberdeen City Council to a member of Aberdeen City Council staff for use in the Marischal College Multi-Storey Off-Street Car Park;

"Car Club" means a formally constituted car-sharing scheme approved by the Council to operate in its boundaries;

"car club parking bay" means an area marked out in one of the parking places specified in the schedule and made available for the parking of a car club vehicle;

"car club vehicle" means a vehicle provided by the car club with the appropriate livery and displaying a car club parking sign;

"car park" means a "parking place";

"charging hours" means the period indicated as such at any point in the schedule hereto;

"charging post" means an installation adjacent to an electric vehicle parking bay for the purposes of recharging the battery of an electric vehicle by way of a connecting lead

"City Warden" means a person authorised by, or on behalf of, the Council to supervise parking bays and issue penalty charge notices;

"disabled person" has the same meaning as in The Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) (Scotland) Regulations 2000;

"disabled person's badge" means: -

- (i) a badge issued under section 21 of the Chronically Sick and Disabled Persons Act 1970;
- (ii) a badge issued under a provision of the law of Northern Ireland corresponding to that section; or
- (iii) a badge issued, corresponding to that section, by a State that is a member or an associate of the European Conference of Ministers of Transport

"disabled person's vehicle" has the same meaning as in S142 (1) of the 1984 Act;

"driver", in relation to a vehicle waiting in a parking place, means the person authorised by the owner to drive the vehicle (and, for the avoidance of doubt includes its owner) who was driving the vehicle at the time it was left in the parking place;

"electric vehicle parking bay" means an area marked out in one of the parking places specified in the schedule and made available for the parking and charging of an electric vehicle

"electronic ticket" means a ticket purchased by the "park and phone" method of payment and stored on a hand-held device;

"hand-held device" means a wireless hand-held computer used by a City Warden which is programmed to interface with the telephone payment parking system;

"maximum period of stay" means a maximum period of uninterrupted parking;

"motorcycle" means a "mechanically propelled vehicle" with fewer than 4 wheels, of which the weight unladen does not exceed 410 kilograms; in accordance with the definition provided in Section 136 of the 1984 Act;

"motorcycle parking bay" means any area marked out in one of the parking places specified in the schedule hereto and made available for the parking of a motorcycle only in that parking bay in accordance with the provisions of this order;

"order" means The Aberdeen City Council (Off-Street Car Parks) Order 2015;

"owner" means the registered keeper of the vehicle at the appropriate time;

"park and phone" means a system to facilitate and monitor the payment of parking charges using mobile telephone via communication with the service, in accordance with the instructions indicated on signs in the car park;

"parking bay" means any area of the parking place which is provided for the waiting of a vehicle in accordance with the provisions of this order and indicated by markings on the surface of the parking place;

"parking place" means any building or area of land commonly identifiable as the referent of its name in Column 1 of the schedule hereto, that has been

provided by (or is managed by) the Council under Section 32 of the Road Traffic Act 1984 for use as a parking place;

"passenger vehicle" means a motor vehicle constructed or adapted solely for the carriage of not more than eight passengers exclusive of the driver; the expression "passenger vehicle" includes a motorcycle as defined in the Act and excludes any caravan or trailer in any circumstances;

"penalty charge" means the charge payable in respect of all contraventions of this order;

"light goods vehicle" means a motor vehicle constructed or adapted for use for the carriage of goods or burden of any description, weighing not more than 3.5 tonnes when laden, and not drawing a trailer;

"residential exemption permit" means a permit issued by Aberdeen City Council to a qualifying resident whose usual place of abode is at premises the address of which is detailed in the order relevant to the on-street controlled parking zone;

"the Act" means the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended;

"vehicle" means a passenger vehicle or light goods vehicle;

Insofar as this order may not provide explicit definition of any term, that term shall be interpreted in accordance with any definition of it in the 1984 Act, or otherwise according to the context of the order in general;

Use of Off-Street Car Parks

- (3) Each off-street parking place shall be used only for parking, and shall be subject to the charging provisions of this order on such days and during such hours as are specified in this order, and, also, under all circumstances, the parking place shall be available for use only by such *classes* of vehicles as are specified in relation to it in the schedule hereto.

Amount and Method of Payment of Charge for Parking in an Off-Street Car Park

- (4) (a) If a vehicle is left in an off-street parking place during charging hours; the driver thereof shall pay a charge in accordance with the provisions of this order, unless the vehicle is exempted from such payment under Article 8, 9, 10 or 11 hereto.
- (b) The charge for a vehicle left in an off-street parking place during the charging hours shall be detailed in relation to that parking place in the schedule hereto.
- (c) This charge shall be payable on leaving the vehicle in the off-street parking place by one of the following means:
- (i) the insertion, in a ticket issuing machine relating to that off-street parking place, of a combination of coins of the denominations

indicated on that ticket issuing machine such that their total value – the fee paid - is equal to or exceeds the relevant charge, as detailed in the schedule hereto. After insertion of the fee paid, the driver of the vehicle shall exhibit the ticket issued by the ticket issuing machine in a conspicuous position facing forward on the near side of the vehicle behind the glass of the windscreen so that all of the front of the said ticket is clearly visible to a person standing at the near side of the vehicle. No other ticket issued by a ticket issuing machine shall be exhibited on the vehicle.

- (ii) the “park and phone” method of payment may be used to pay the relevant charge, as detailed in the schedule hereto. If this method is used, registration of payment must be made by phone or electronic means. On the first use only, the driver shall register the credit or debit card payment details and the relevant registration number of the vehicle being left at the parking place, along with the location number of where they wish to park and the duration. Thereafter, on all other occasions, the driver shall provide the location number of the car parking place, the duration that they wish to park and the CVV2 code of the registered credit or debit card, or any other such details the Council may require in order for a relevant payment to be made for the required time of use of the parking place. Where a driver has made payment through the telephone payment parking system, an indication (the “electronic ticket”) that payment of the parking charge has been made shall appear on a hand-held device, operated by City Wardens.

Restriction on Removal of Tickets and Notices

- (5) (a) When a ticket has been exhibited on a vehicle in accordance with the provisions of this order, no person, not being the driver of the vehicle, shall remove the ticket from the vehicle unless authorised to do so by the driver. Further, when a ticket has been exhibited in accordance with the provisions of this order, no person shall transfer such ticket for use on another vehicle.
- (b) Where a penalty charge notice has been attached to a vehicle in accordance with the provisions of this order, no person, not being the driver of the vehicle or a City Warden, shall remove the notice from the vehicle unless authorised to do so by the driver.

Ticket Issuing Machines to be installed at Off-Street Car Parks

- (6) There shall be at least one ticket issuing machine in or in the vicinity of each off-street parking place in respect of which charging is applicable.

Indications by Ticket Issued or Park and Phone “Electronic Ticket” on the Hand-Held Device

- (7) (a) Payment of the relevant charge for a vehicle left in an off-street parking place shall be indicated by the issue and subsequent exhibition of the

ticket referred to in Article 4(c)(i) of this order, or on the hand-held device referred to in Article 4(c)(ii)

- (b) The expiry of the period for which the relevant charge has been paid shall be indicated:
 - (i) when there is exhibited on the vehicle a ticket, issued by a ticket issuing machine relating to the off-street parking place at which the vehicle has been left, indicating a day and time, and where the time shown on the clock on the said ticket issuing machine is later than the time shown on the ticket; or
 - (ii) a "park and phone" payment is made relating to the off-street parking place at which the vehicle has been left, and the time indicated on the hand-held device is later than the time indicated on an electronic ticket.

Monthly Tickets

- (8) (a) Car park-specific monthly season tickets shall be available at a cost of £210 a month. A monthly season ticket will permit a vehicle to be parked at any off-street car park detailed in the schedule hereto without payment of charge, but not in respect of those with a maximum period of stay of less than ten hours.
- (b) The ticket referred to in this Article shall be exhibited in a conspicuous position behind the windscreen of the registered vehicle, in accordance with the provisions of this order, during any such period as that vehicle is left in the car park.

NHS Grampian Health Village Parking Permits

- (9) (a) NHS Grampian may apply to the Council for the issue of up to thirty-five flexible (non car specific) NHS Grampian Health Village Parking Permits at no charge for use on qualifying vehicles, the keepers of which are employees of NHS Grampian, which, when displayed in a conspicuous position behind the windscreen of his or her vehicle, will allow the vehicle to be left in any parking space within Frederick Street off-street car park only, and, also, suspend the need to buy and display an appropriate ticket before making use of a parking space in this off-street car park. Any such application shall be made in accordance with the procedure prescribed by the Council, which procedure may be varied from time to time by the Council.
- (b) The Council may at any time require NHS Grampian to produce to an officer of the Council:
 - (i) in respect of an application for a NHS Grampian Health Village Parking Permit, such evidence as they may reasonably require to verify any particulars or information given to them: or
 - (ii) in respect of any previously issued Grampian Health Village Parking Permit, such evidence as they may reasonably require

to verify that the permit is valid and/or that the individual permit holder remains entitled to the said permit.

Aberdeen City Council Staff Parking Permits – Marischal College Multi-Storey Off-Street Car Park

- (10) A vehicle, when displaying a current Aberdeen City Council Staff Parking Permit valid for Marischal College off-street car park in a conspicuous position behind the windscreen of his or her vehicle, and released by the proper officer of the Council, shall be exempt from payment of any charge between the operational hours of 6pm to 8pm, Monday to Friday, only.

Manner of Standing in Off-Street Car Parks

- (11) Every vehicle left in an off-street parking place where individual parking bays are marked shall only use that off-street parking place by parking within such a parking bay, and stand in such a way that every part of the vehicle is within the limits of that stall.

Exemption from Parking Charges and Time Limits

- (12) (a) Where all the ticket issuing machines at the said parking place carry notices placed upon them by a person duly authorised by the Council indicating they are out of order, the driver of a vehicle shall be exempt from the payment of a charge; provided the vehicle does not remain in the parking place for longer than the maximum period of stay allowed in the parking place.
- (b) A disabled person's vehicle shall be exempt from payment of any charge, and from compliance with any limitation of time, in respect of any off-street parking place specified in this order, providing there is displayed a disabled person's badge in a conspicuous position behind the windscreen of the vehicle.

Movement of Vehicles in Car Parks in Emergencies

- (13) A police officer or any person duly authorised by the Council, may, in case of emergency, move or cause to be moved, to any place thought fit, any vehicle left in a parking place.

Powers to Suspend or Reserve Use of Car Parks

- (14) (a) Any persons duly authorised in that behalf by the Council may suspend or reserve the use of an off-street parking place, or any part thereof, whenever and for such period as he may consider reasonable, and nothing in this order shall oblige the Council to retain the parking place, or any part thereof, as a building or area provided in pursuance of the Act as a parking place.
- (b) Any person suspending or reserving the use of an off-street parking place or any part thereof in accordance with the provisions of the immediately preceding paragraph, shall place or cause to be placed in

or adjacent to that parking place, or the relevant part thereof, a sign or signs indicating that waiting is prohibited.

Reservation of Parking Bays for Disabled Drivers

- (15) The Council may reserve in any of the parking places affected by this order a suitable number of parking bays for disabled persons' vehicles, and no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to wait in such a space at any time without displaying a valid disabled person's badge in a conspicuous position behind the windscreen of his or her vehicle.

Reservation of Parking Bays for Motorcycle Parking

- (16) The Council may reserve in any of the parking places affected by this order a suitable number of parking bays for motorcycles. No person shall cause or permit any type of vehicle other than a motorcycle to park in a motorcycle parking bay at any time. A motorcycle shall be exempt from payment of any charge, and from compliance with any limitation of time, in respect of any off-street parking place specified in this order, providing that it is located within one of the motorcycle parking bays established by the Council.

Reservation of Parking Bays for Electric Vehicle Parking and Charging

- (17) The Council may reserve in any of the parking places affected by this order a suitable number of parking bays as electric vehicle parking bays. No person shall cause or permit any type of vehicle other than an electric vehicle to park in an electric vehicle parking bay at any time. At all times whilst an electric vehicle is parked in an electric vehicle parking bay, the driver shall cause the vehicle to be connected via a recharging lead to the charging post installed in respect of the parking bay. An electric vehicle parking bay shall be subject to the charging provisions of this order on such days and during such hours as are specified in this order.

Reservation of Parking Bays for Car Club Vehicles

- (18) The Council may reserve in any of the parking places affected by this order a suitable number of parking bays for vehicles provided by the Car Club. No person shall cause or permit any type of vehicle other than a car club vehicle to park in a car club parking bay at any time. A car club vehicle shall be exempt from payment of any charge, and from compliance with any limitation of time, in respect of any off-street parking place specified in this order, providing that it is located within one of the car club parking bays established by the Council.

Limited Applicability of On-Street Residential Permits in Off-Street Car Parks

- (19) Any resident within the On-Street Controlled Parking Zone A, or Zone C, or Zone K, who is the holder of a residential exemption permit which is displayed in a conspicuous position on the windscreen of the relevant vehicle, shall at no charge, be eligible to park, between 6.00pm and 8.00pm, Monday to Saturday, inclusively, in the Chapel Street Multi-Storey Car Park and the lower ground floor of Denburn Multi-Storey Car Park.

- (20) Any resident within On-Street Controlled Parking Zone F, or Zone G, who is the holder of a residential exemption permit which is displayed in a conspicuous position on the windscreen of the relevant vehicle, shall at no charge, be eligible to park, between 6.00pm and 8.00pm, Monday to Saturday, inclusively, in the West North Street Multi-Storey Car Park and Virginia Street Car Park.

Kingswells Park & Ride

- (21) Parking bays in the upper level of the Kingswells Park & Ride parking place will be reserved for the exclusive use of drivers using the bus service associated with this facility, and no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to wait in such a parking bay unless they are using the aforementioned bus service.

Altens Farm Road Car Park

- (22) Save as provided by Article 24, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to wait in Altens Farm Road Car Park between 8.00am and 6.00pm on any day, except Saturdays and Sundays:
- (i) for a period longer than 3 hours, or
 - (ii) if a period of less than 3 hours has elapsed since the termination of the last period of waiting (if any) of the vehicle in that car park.

Duthie Park Car Park

- (23) Save as provided by Article 24, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to wait in Duthie Park Car Park between 8.00am and 4.00pm on any day, except Saturdays and Sundays:
- (i) for a period longer than 3 hours, or
 - (ii) if a period of less than 1 hour has elapsed since the termination of the last period of waiting (if any) of the vehicle in that car park.

- (24) Nothing in Articles 22 and 23 of this order shall apply to any invalid carriage or disabled person's vehicle which displays in the relevant position a valid disabled person's badge.

Penalty Charge

- (25) (a) A charge amounting to sixty pounds (which amount shall hereinafter be known as the "penalty charge") shall be payable, in addition to the relevant charge which may already have been paid as required in Article 4 of the order, when a vehicle is left in one of the parking places in the schedule to this order, in respect of which charging is applicable, for longer than the period for which payment of the relevant charge was made, or if a vehicle is left in a parking place otherwise than in accordance with the provisions of this order.

- (b) In the case of a vehicle, in respect of which the penalty charge has been incurred, it shall be the duty of the City Warden to attach to the vehicle, in a conspicuous position, a notice which shall include:-
- (i) the registration mark of the vehicle or, when the vehicle is being used under a trade licence, the number of the trade plate carried by the vehicle;
 - (ii) the time at which he or she first notices (i) that, the initial charge having been paid, the ticket obtained from the ticket issuing machine has not been exhibited on the vehicle in accordance with the provisions of the order, or (ii) that the vehicle has been left in a parking bay during charging hours for longer than the period for which payment of the appropriate initial charge has been made, or (iii) that the vehicle has been parked such that it does not conform with the manner of standing specified in this order; or (iv) an apparent breach of the relevant provisions contained in this order.
 - (iii) a statement that the excess charge of Sixty Pounds requires to be paid;
 - (iv) the manner in which and the time within which, and also any special conditions according to which, the excess charge should or can be paid; and
 - (v) a statement that a driver who fails to pay any excess charge shall be guilty of an offence in terms of the Act.
- (26) When a vehicle is left in any parking place in contravention of any of the provisions of this order, a person authorised in that behalf, by or on behalf of the Council, may remove, or arrange to have removed, the said vehicle from the parking place. When a vehicle is left in a parking place, in a position other than a position in which it may wait in accordance with this order, a person authorised in that behalf, by or on behalf of the Council, may later, or cause to be altered, the position of the vehicle. The Council may, by written notice, require the owner of such vehicle to remove the vehicle from a parking place, or from any place to which it has been removed for safe custody
- (27) Any person removing, or altering the position of, any vehicle by virtue of the previous Article may do so by towing or driving or moving it in such other manner as he may think necessary to enable him to remove it or alter its position, as the case may be, provided that in the event of any vehicle being removed from any parking place, such person shall make such arrangements as may be reasonably necessary for the safe custody of the vehicle.
- (28) Where a vehicle has been removed in accordance with Article 26, the Council shall be entitled to recover from any person responsible for that vehicle such charges in respect of the removal and any subsequent storage and disposal of the vehicle.


Revocation

SCHEDULE

In the following schedule of off-street parking places, column 1 gives the location and name of each off-street parking place affected by this order, column 2 shows, where appropriate, the days and times during which charging is applicable, column 3 lists the class or classes of vehicle permitted to use each off-street car park, and column 4 states any applicable charge and time limit.

The charges indicated in this schedule apply to an individual ticket purchased for and valid for a single visit to a single off-street parking place. Each charge indicated in column 4 is required to be paid by purchasing a ticket relating to it (in that it will expire at the end of the period stipulated in that column as applicable to that charge). The period stipulated in column 4 shall be taken to continue into (and expire) during the *next* day's charging hours wherever it has not already expired during the charging hours on the day it was purchased.


