THE EAST RENFREWSHIRE COUNCIL

(DISABLED PERSONS' PARKING BAYS) (OFF-STREET PARKING) ORDER 2015

Preamble and Definitions

The East Renfrewshire Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Sections 32 and 35 and Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("The Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Constable of Police Scotland in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby make the following Order.

- This Order may be cited as "The East Renfrewshire Council (Disabled Person's Parking Bays)
 (Off-Street Parking) Order 2015" and shall come into operation on 22 May 2015.
- 2. In this Order the following expressions have the meanings hereby assigned to them:-

"vehicle", unless the context otherwise requires, means a vehicle of any description and includes a machine or implement of any kind drawn or propelled along roads whether or not by mechanical power;

"disabled person's badge" has the same meaning as in the Local Authorities Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (Scotland) Regulations 2002;

"disabled person's vehicle" means a vehicle lawfully displaying a valid disabled person's badge in the relevant position;

"relevant position" has the same meaning as in Regulation 3 of the Local Authorities Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Person's) (Scotland) Regulations 2002;

"emergency service vehicle" means a vehicle being used by the police, fire brigade or ambulance services;

"local authority" means East Renfrewshire Council;

"Council" means the East Renfrewshire Council;

"parking bay" means a space in a parking place which is provided for the leaving of a vehicle and is appropriately signed as per the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002;

"parking attendant" has the same meaning as in Section 63A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

Note:

- (i) All words importing the singular also include the plural and vice versa where the context requires.
- (ii) Except where the context otherwise requires, references to any enactment include any such enactment as amended, extended or applied or re-enacted by or under any other enactment for the time being in force. Enactment means orders, rules, regulations, directions, bylaws and other Instruments made or to be made, issued or given under any Act or deriving validity therefrom.
- (iii) All signs, carriageway markings etc shall comply with the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002.

Section 1 - No Waiting Except by Vehicles Bearing Disabled Persons' Badge

- 1/01 The parking bays designated in Schedules 1 4 inclusive shall only be used for the leaving of disabled persons' vehicles.
- 1/02 The parking bays designated in this Order shall apply to any disabled person's vehicle which is not causing an obstruction and which displays in the relevant position a disabled person's badge.
- 1/03 No person shall cause or permit a vehicle to wait in the parking bays designated in Schedules 1-4 inclusive unless the vehicle is a disabled person's vehicle which bears in the relevant position a valid disabled person's badge.
- 1/04 Every vehicle left in a parking bay designated in this Order shall so stand such that no bay Is occupied by more than one vehicle and that every part of the vehicle is within the limits of a parking bay.
- 1/05 Nothing in Article 1/03 of this Order shall:
 - (a) prevent any person from causing or permitting a vehicle to wait or load in any of the parking bays referred to in these Articles:-
 - (i) for so long as may be necessary to enable the vehicle if it cannot be conveniently used for such purposes in any other parking bay, to be used in connection with the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of any of the parking bay so referred to, or the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or near to any of the said parking bay, of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity, or of any telecommunications apparatus, as defined in the Telecommunications Act, 1984;
 - (ii) to enable the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other parking bay, to be used in pursuance of statutory powers and duties and in particular, but without prejudice to the generality of the foregoing, to enable the vehicle to be used in connection with police, fire brigade and ambulance purposes;

- (iii) if the vehicle is waiting owing to the driver being prevented from proceeding by circumstances beyond his/her control or to such waiting being necessary in order to avoid an accident;
- (b) apply to an emergency service vehicle.
- 1/06 Any persons duly authorised by the local authority, a traffic warden, a police officer or parking attendant in uniform may move or cause to be moved in case of an emergency, to any place they think fit, vehicles left in a parking bay.
- 1/07 No person shall leave a vehicle in a parking bay for a period longer than twenty four hours without the permission of a person duly authorised by the local authority

Section 2 Power to suspend the use of a parking bay

- 2/01 Any person duly authorised by the Council may suspend the use a parking bay or any part thereof whenever it is considered such a suspension is reasonably necessary:
 - (i) For the purposes of facilitating the movement of traffic or its safety;
 - (ii) For the purposes of any building operation, demolition, or excavation in or adjacent to the parking bay or the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the parking bay or the laying, erection alteration, removal or repair in or adjacent to the parking bay of any traffic sign, parking ticket machine, sewer, or of any main pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telecommunication apparatus as defined in sub-paragraph of Schedule 2 of the Telecommunications Act 1984;
 - (iii) For the convenience of occupiers of premises adjacent to the parking bay on any occasion of the removal of furniture from one office or dwellinghouse to another or the removal of furniture from such premises to a depository or to such premises from a depository;
 - (iv) For the convenience of occupiers of premises adjacent to the parking bay at times of weddings funerals or other special occasions;
 - (v) On any occasion on which it is likely by reason of some special attraction or procession that any off street car park be thronged or obstructed; or
 - (vi) For any other purpose which the Council may from time to time see fit and which has received their prior approval.
- 2/02 Any person suspending the use of a parking bay or any part thereof in accordance with the provisions of paragraph 2/01 of this Article shall thereupon place or cause to be placed in or adjacent to any part of that parking bay the use of which is suspended a traffic sign indicating that:
 - (i) waiting by vehicles is prohibited; or
 - (ii) limited waiting during prescribed hours is suspended.
- 2/03 No person shall cause or permit a vehicle to be left in any part of a parking bay during such period as there is in or adjacent to that part of the parking bay a traffic sign placed in pursuance of paragraph 2/02 of this Article:- provided that nothing in this paragraph shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle being used for fire brigade, ambulance or police emergency purposes to be left or any other vehicle to be so left if that vehicle is left with the permission of the Council suspending the use of the parking place or the part

thereof in pursuance of paragraph 2/01 of this Article or of a police constable in uniform or a parking attendant in uniform.

Section 3

3/01 Those Orders specified in Schedule 5 to this Order are hereby revoked.

This Order together with the Schedules annexed and signed as relative hereto are given under the seal of the East Renfrewshire Council and signed for them and on their behalf by Joseph George Abrami, Principal Solicitor and duly authorised signatory together at Giffnock on the 7 April 2015.
