

**THE GLASGOW CITY COUNCIL (CITY CENTRE) (TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT) ORDER 2010 (VARIATION NO.18)(ELECTRIC VEHICLE PARKING CHARGE) ORDER 2016**

Glasgow City Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Sections 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 20, 32, 35, 37, 45, 46, 47, 48, 49, 51, 52, 53 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Constable of Police Scotland in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby make the following Order:-

**Citation and Commencement**

- a) This Order may be cited as "The Glasgow City Council (City Centre) (Traffic Management) Order 2010 (Variation No.18) (Electric Vehicle Parking Charge) Order 2016" and shall come into operation on 7<sup>th</sup> of November 2016.
- b) The Orders specified in Schedule 1 to this Order shall have the effect subject to the amendments specified in that Schedule.
- c) Any reference to this Order to any enactment shall be constructed as a reference to that enactment as amended by any subsequent enactment.

Vehicles for which Electric Vehicle Electric vehicle parking places are designated.

Insert the following

(iii).- No person shall cause an electric vehicle to wait in an electric vehicle parking places for longer than three hours.

(iv).- No person shall cause an electric vehicle which has been removed after waiting in an electric vehicle parking place to wait again in that electric vehicle parking place within a period of three hours.

Electric Vehicle Electric vehicle parking places charges

Remove

11. The parking charge is 0 pence for the first 30 minutes and 0 pence for every 10 minute thereafter

Insert the following

11. The parking charge is 20 pence for the first 30 minutes, then 20 pence for 10 minutes thereafter, as amended from time to time by notice.

Add new Articles pertaining to Schedule 33(a)

Meter feeding

13.- Any vehicle which has been left in an electric vehicle parking place, must, after the expiration of the maximum parking time, be removed from that electric vehicle parking place. The maximum parking time in the electric vehicle parking place is as stated in Article 12 hereof and this time must not be exceeded. This applies during the hours of Monday to Saturday 8am to 6pm.

Restriction of trading at electric vehicle parking places

14.-No person shall use any vehicle or trailer, while it is in an electric vehicle parking place, in connection with the sale or offering for sale of any article to any person in or near the electric vehicle parking place or in connection with the selling or offering for sale of their skill in handicraft or their services in any other capacity, or for the purpose of advertising.

Add new Articles pertaining to Schedule 33(a)

Amount of parking charge at electric vehicle parking places

15.-Save as provided in Article 19 hereof, the parking charge for a vehicle left in an electric vehicle parking place designated in Schedule 33(a), during the hours of Monday to Saturday 8am to 6pm, shall, subject as hereinafter provided, be in accordance with the rates in Article 11 hereof and subject to a maximum parking time in accordance with Article 12 hereof.

Method of payment of parking charge

16.- (i)The parking charge as specified in Article 11 hereof shall be payable on the leaving of the vehicle in the electric vehicle parking place. Payment shall be made using the parking ticket machine and using the method of payment accepted by the parking ticket machine, and;

- (ii) The driver, or person authorised by the driver of the vehicle, shall exhibit on the vehicle, in accordance with the provisions of paragraphs (iii), (iv) and (v) of this Article, the parking ticket issued by the parking ticket machine at the time of payment;
- (iii) A parking ticket shall be valid for a single stay only and no other parking ticket issued by another parking ticket machine shall be displayed;
- (iv) The parking ticket shall be exhibited on the vehicle: -
  - a) in the case of a two-wheeled motorcycle having a sidecar attached thereto, or any other vehicle not having a windscreen, in a conspicuous position on the near side of the vehicle in front of the driving seat;
  - b) in the case of any other vehicle, in a conspicuous position facing forward on the inside of the glass of the windscreen.
- (v) The parking ticket shall be so exhibited on the vehicle so that the time and other details indicated on the front thereof are clearly visible to a person standing at the near side of the vehicle.

Add new Articles pertaining to Schedule 33(a)

Indications by parking tickets

- 17.(i) Payment of the parking charge for a vehicle left in an electric vehicle parking place designated in Article 11 hereof shall be indicated by a parking ticket issued from a parking ticket machine at or near the electric vehicle parking place. This parking ticket shall be numbered to indicate the identity of the issuing machine. It will identify the amount of parking charge that has been paid and the date and time of payment or the amount of parking charge that has been paid and the date and time when the permitted parking in terms of the parking ticket will expire. Exhibition of any parking ticket shall be in accordance with the provisions of Article 16 hereof;
- (ii) The expiry of the period for which the parking charge has been paid shall take place when the time shown on the clock on the parking ticket machine is later than the expiry time shown on the parking ticket.
- (iii) If the parking ticket machine, at the electric vehicle parking place at which the vehicle is left, is out of order an alternative machine must be used. The alternative machine shall display the same parking charge tariffs and maximum parking time as the machine nearest the electric vehicle parking place in which the vehicle is left.

Indications by parking ticket machines and parking tickets as evidence of Permitted Parking

- 18.(i) If a vehicle is left in an electric vehicle parking place and no parking ticket is exhibited on that vehicle in accordance with the provisions of Article 18 hereof it shall be presumed that the parking charge has not been duly paid;
- (ii) If a vehicle is left in an electric vehicle parking place the clock on the parking ticket machine relating to the electric vehicle parking place in which the vehicle is left and the parking ticket exhibited on the vehicle and issued from the parking ticket machine gives the indication mentioned in Article 18 (ii) hereof, it shall be presumed that the parking charge has been duly paid and that the period for which payment was made by the parking charge has already expired.

Exemption from charges

19. No vehicle left during the hours of Monday to Saturday 8am to 6pm in an electric vehicle parking place designated in Schedule 33(a) shall be exempt from the parking charges specified in Article 11 hereof.

11. The parking charge is 0 pence for the first 30 minutes and 0 pence for every 10 minute thereafter

Insert the following

11. The parking charge for each 12 minute stay is 60 pence. If paying using the mobile phone option the parking charges are £3 for 1 hour and £6 for 2 hours. The parking charges and other fees may be amended from time to time by notice

Maximum parking time

Remove

12. The maximum time that a vehicle is permitted to park in an Electric Vehicle Charging Place is 3 hours.

Insert the following

12. The maximum time that a vehicle is permitted to park in an Electric Vehicle Charging Place during the hours of Monday to Saturday 8am to 6pm is 2 hours.

Meter feeding

13.- Any vehicle which has been left in an electric vehicle parking place, must, after the expiration of the maximum parking time, be removed from that electric vehicle parking place. The maximum parking time in the electric vehicle parking place is as stated in Article 12 hereof and this time must not be exceeded. This applies during the hours of Monday to Saturday 8am to 6pm.

Method of payment of parking charge

16.- (i) The parking charge as specified in Article 11 hereof shall be payable on the leaving of the vehicle in the electric vehicle parking place. Payment shall be made using the parking ticket machine and using the method of payment accepted by the parking ticket machine, and;

(ii) The driver, or person authorised by the driver of the vehicle, shall exhibit on the vehicle, in accordance with the provisions of paragraphs (iii), (iv) and (v) of this Article, the parking ticket issued by the parking ticket machine at the time of payment;

(iii) A parking ticket shall be valid for a single stay only and no other parking ticket issued by another parking ticket machine shall be displayed;

(iv) The parking ticket shall be exhibited on the vehicle: -

c) in the case of a two-wheeled motorcycle having a sidecar attached thereto, or any other vehicle not having a windscreen, in a conspicuous position on the near side of the vehicle in front of the driving seat;

d) in the case of any other vehicle, in a conspicuous position facing forward on the inside of the glass of the windscreen.

(vi) The parking ticket shall be so exhibited on the vehicle so that the time and other details indicated on the front thereof are clearly visible to a person standing at the near side of the vehicle.

Indications by parking tickets

- 17.(i) Payment of the parking charge for a vehicle left in an electric vehicle parking place designated in Article 11 hereof shall be indicated by a parking ticket issued from a parking ticket machine at or near the electric vehicle parking place. This parking ticket shall be numbered to indicate the identity of the issuing machine. It will identify the amount of parking charge that has been paid and the date and time of payment or the amount of parking charge that has been paid and the date and time when the permitted parking in terms of the parking ticket will expire. Exhibition of any parking ticket shall be in accordance with the provisions of Article 16 hereof;
- (ii) The expiry of the period for which the parking charge has been paid shall take place when the time shown on the clock on the parking ticket machine is later than the expiry time shown on the parking ticket.
- (iii) If the parking ticket machine, at the electric vehicle parking place at which the vehicle is left, is out of order an alternative machine must be used. The alternative machine shall display the same parking charge tariffs and maximum parking time as the machine nearest the electric vehicle parking place in which the vehicle is left.

Indications by parking ticket machines and parking tickets as evidence of Permitted Parking

- 18.(i) If a vehicle is left in an electric vehicle parking place and no parking ticket is exhibited on that vehicle in accordance with the provisions of Article 17 hereof it shall be presumed that the parking charge has not been duly paid;
- (ii) If a vehicle is left in an electric vehicle parking place the clock on the parking ticket machine relating to the electric vehicle parking place in which the vehicle is left and the parking ticket exhibited on the vehicle and issued from the parking ticket machine gives the indication mentioned in Article 18 (ii) hereof, it shall be presumed that the parking charge has been duly paid and that the period for which payment was made by the parking charge has already expired.

Exemption from charges

19. No vehicle left during the hours of Monday to Saturday 8am to 6pm in an electric vehicle parking place designated in Schedule 35(b) shall be exempt from the parking charges specified in Article 11 hereof.
