Glasgow City Council in exercise of the powers conferred upon them under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Constable of Police Scotland in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act, hereby make the following Order.


Citation and Commencement

This Order may be cited as the "Glasgow City Council (City Centre) (**T**raffic Management) Order 2010 (Variation No 17) Order 2016 and shall come into operation on 14 October 2016.

 - purpose of facilitating the movement of vehicular or pedestrian traffic, or for promoting its safety or where the Council deems it necessary to facilitate a particular operation or event; or
 - b) purpose of any building or roadwork's operations or works associated with the provision or maintenance of public utilities, provided that prior permission has been granted by the Council, including works being done by the Council or on the Council's behalf.
 - (ii) Any person suspending the use of an Electric Vehicle Parking Place or any part thereof in accordance with

 - the vehicle is waiting only for as long as may be necessary to enable it to be used in connection with the removal of any obstruction to traffic; or
 - the vehicle is waiting only for so long as may be reasonably necessary to enable it to be used for any purpose specified in Article 7 (i) (b) hereof; or

Provided that a person causing or permitting a vehicle to wait in an Electric Vehicle Parking Place by virtue of Article 8 hereof shall take all such steps as are necessary to ensure that the longitudinal axis of the vehicle is parallel to the edge of the carriageway nearest to the vehicle and the distance between the said edge and the nearest wheel of the vehicle is not more than 300mm.

Nothing in the foregoing provisions of this Article shall be taken as authorising anything which would be a contravention of any Regulations made or having effect as if made under Section 25 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984.
