ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984**

**PERTH AND KINROSS COUNCIL (OFF-STREET CAR PARKS) ORDER 2015  
(NO/08/15)**

Perth and Kinross Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Sections 35(1) and (3) of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (which Act of 1984 is hereinafter referred to as "the Act") and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf and after consultation with the Chief Constable in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby make the following Order:-

**PART I  
GENERAL PROVISIONS**

**Commencement and Citation**

1. This Order may be cited as the "Perth and Kinross Council (Off-Street Car Parks) Order 2015" and shall come into operation on the Thirty-first day of March Two thousand and fifteen.

**Interpretation**

2.
  - (i) In this Order, except where the context otherwise requires, the following expressions shall have the meanings hereby respectively assigned to them:-

"**articulated vehicle**" means a heavy motor vehicle or motor vehicle, not being an articulated bus, with a trailer so attached that part of the trailer is superimposed upon the drawing vehicle, and when the trailer is uniformly loaded, not less than 20 per cent of the weight of its load is borne by the drawing vehicle;

"**car park**" means any area of land including accesses and exits specified by name in Column 1 of the Schedule to this Order provided by the Council in pursuance of Section 32(1) of the Act for use as a parking place as defined therein but excluding any parking place which forms any part of a road;

"**caravan**" means a vehicle designed or adapted for human habitation;

"**charging days**" and "**charging hours**" means the days and the hours during which a payment is required for the leaving of a vehicle in a car park

- (a) as specified at Columns 4 and 5 respectively of the Schedule opposite to the name of each car park; or
- (b) at such other times as may be determined by the Council;

but excludes non-charging days as determined by the Council;

"**Chief Constable**" means the Chief Constable of Police Scotland;

"**coach parking space**" means a bay in a car park which is provided for the waiting of large passenger vehicles the limits of which are indicated by means of surface markings in the style of Diagram 1025.1/3/4 of the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002;

"**Council**" means the Perth and Kinross Council;

"**disabled persons**" means a disabled person of a description prescribed by Regulation 4 of The Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) Scotland Regulations 2000 (as amended 2011);

"**disabled person's badge**" has the meaning assigned to it by Regulation 11 of the said Regulations of 2000 (as amended 2011);

"**disabled person's vehicle**" means a motor vehicle which is displaying a disabled person's badge in accordance with the said Regulations of 2000 (as amended 2011);

"**electric charging vehicle**" means a motor vehicle which has been constructed to be propelled by electricity; /

electricity;

"**heavy goods vehicles**" means any of the following vehicles:-

- (a) an articulated goods vehicle; or
- (b) a large goods vehicle, that is to say, a motor vehicle (not being an articulated goods vehicle) which is constructed or adapted to carry or to haul goods and the permissible maximum weight of which exceeds 7.5 tonnes, and may include such a large goods vehicle with a heavy trailer in tow;

"**heavy trailer**" means a vehicle which is drawn by a motor vehicle and has an unladen weight exceeding 1525 kilograms;

"**heavy vehicles**" means heavy goods vehicles and large passenger vehicles as defined herein;

"**large passenger vehicle**" means a mechanically propelled vehicle designed and constructed for the carriage of more than 15 persons, inclusive of the driver, whether for hire or reward or not;

"**maximum charging period**" means the longest period of charging hours during which a vehicle may be left in a car park, being the period specified at Column 8 of the Schedule opposite to the name of the car park;

"**motor vehicle**" means a mechanically propelled vehicle intended or adapted for use on roads;

"**owner**" means for the purposes of this Order the person by whom a vehicle is kept;

"**parking charge**" means the amount payable by any person leaving a vehicle in a car park during the charging days and charging hours and will be of the rate specified in Column 6 of the Schedule, and will be of the relative amounts as specified in the current Schedule of Off-Street parking charges;

"**parking space**" means a bay in a car park which is provided for the leaving of a vehicle the limits of which are indicated by means of surface markings or by different coloured blockwork;

"**passenger vehicle**" means a motor vehicle constructed solely for the carriage of passengers and their effects and adapted to carry not more than 15 persons inclusive of the driver and not drawing a trailer as defined in Section 136 of the Act or a caravan, and includes a motor cycle (but not a solo motor cycle as defined below) as defined in the said Section of the Act;

"**penalty charge notice**" has the meaning assigned to it by Section 66 of the Road Traffic Act 1991;

"**refrigeration vehicle**" means a goods vehicle fitted with an ancillary motor which is being used in connection with cold storage equipment;

"**relevant position**" means, in the case of a vehicle fitted with a front windscreen, immediately behind and on the nearside of the windscreen with the obverse side of the permit, badge or ticket facing forwards and in the case of a vehicle not fitted with a front windscreen, on the front or nearside of the vehicle in a conspicuous position;

"**Season Ticket**" means the amount payable by any person leaving a vehicle in a parking place during the metered parking hours and may be for a short term, a medium term or a long term as may be indicated in column 7, of the Schedule and will be of such amount as is specified relative thereto in Column 6, of the said Schedule;

"**Schedule**" means the Schedule to this Order;

"**Schedule of Charges**" means the current Perth and Kinross Council Schedule of Off-Street Parking Charges;

"**semi-trailer**"/

"**semi-trailer**" means a trailer which is constructed or adapted to form part of an articulated vehicle;

"**Servicing Area**" means any car park or part of a car park which has been set aside solely for the parking of vehicles involved in serving buildings adjacent to that servicing area;

"**small goods vehicle**" means a motor vehicle which is constructed or adapted to carry or haul goods and the permissible maximum weight of which does not exceed 3.5 tonnes;

"**small trailer**" means a vehicle which is drawn by a motor vehicle and has an unladen weight not exceeding 1525 kilograms;

"**small vehicles**" means passenger vehicles, small goods vehicles and small trailers all as defined herein;

"**solo motor cycle**" means a mechanically propelled vehicle, with not more than two wheels and the weight of which when unladen does not exceed 410 kilograms;

"**ticket**" means a ticket or tickets issued by a ticket issuing machine relating to any car park designated in this Order;

"**ticket issuing machine**" means apparatus designed to indicate the time by a clock and to issue numbered tickets each of which will indicate the payment of a charge, and either (a) the period in respect of which it has been paid and the day and time at which the charge was paid, or (b) the day and expiry time of the period in respect of which it has been paid, together with the identification mark of the machine from which the ticket has been issued;

"**trailer**" means a vehicle drawn by a motor vehicle;

"**vehicle**" means a vehicle of any description and includes a machine or implement of any kind drawn or propelled along roads whether by animal or mechanical powers.

(ii) In this Order the following symbols and abbreviations shall have the meanings hereby assigned to them:-

"**PMD**" means purchase of a ticket from a ticket issuing machine relating to the car park in which a vehicle is left and the display of the said ticket on the vehicle;

"**RSO**" means Season Ticket facility available only to nearby residents;

"**POE**" means the driver will be required to pay the appropriate parking fee as they exit the car park.

(iii) Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended by any subsequent amendment.

## PART II USE OF CAR PARKS

### Use of Land as Car Parks

3. Each area of land specified in name in Column 1 of the Schedule, but excluding any area of land which has been or may be duly appointed as a stance for taxis, may be used, subject to the provisions of this Order and shall hereinafter be referred to, as a car park for 24 hours per day on all days of the week.

4. Notwithstanding the generality of Article 3 of this Order, no vehicle may be left in a car park:-  
(a) during any period specified in Column 2 of the Schedule opposite to the name of the car park if it is:-  
(i) of a class, or  
(ii) exceeds a height  
specified/

- specified in Column 3 of the said Part of the Schedule opposite to the name of the car park;
- (b) if it is a semi-trailer or a heavy trailer, except in a Servicing Area;
  - (c) for more than 72 consecutive hours, except in a Servicing Area;
  - (d) in a space marked for a disabled person's vehicle unless it is displaying a disabled person's badge;
  - (e) in a space marked for a vehicle designed and constructed to be propelled by electricity, supplied by a battery or other form of electrical cell or reservoir, contained within the said vehicle and rechargeable from a power point connected to the national electricity grid, left in a parking bay signed as a bay for "Electric Vehicles Only".

Any offending vehicle within any of the parking places detailed in the schedule of this Order, shall be subject to a penalty charge.

- 5. Perth and Kinross Council does not accept liability for any loss or damage to vehicles or contents unless due to the negligence of Perth and Kinross Council or its employees.

### **PART III CHARGES**

#### **Parking Charge- Amount and Method of Payment and Display of Tickets**

- 6. (1) Subject to Articles 3, 4, 14, 15, 16, 19 and 34 of this Order and to paragraphs (2) and (3) hereof a parking charge will be payable in respect of a vehicle left in a car park during charging hours if a charge rate is specified in column 6 or 12 of the Schedule opposite to the name of that car park.
  - (2) The parking charge for a small vehicle left in a car park shall be at the rate specified for that car park in column 6 of the Schedule, and for a heavy vehicle, where the leaving of such a vehicle is permitted in terms of Article 18(2) of this Order, shall be at the rate specified for that car park in column 12.
  - (3) The parking charge shall be paid either:-
    - (a) by insertion of coins in a ticket issuing machine situated in a car park in which the vehicle is left, and evidence of the payment shall be the issue of a ticket by an attendant, or by a ticket issuing machine in terms of Article 11(1) of this Order as the case may be, and the exhibition of that ticket in accordance with the provisions of paragraphs (5) and (6) hereof, or
    - (b) to an attendant when a vehicle is being driven or towed out of a car park;
- and the method (amount) of payment applicable to each car park shall be the method (amount) indicated at column 6 (for small vehicles) and column 12 (for heavy vehicles) of the Schedule.
- (4) Subject to the restriction imposed by Article 7(2) of this Order any person who has paid a parking charge shall be entitled, before the expiry of the period in respect of which the charge was paid, to pay one or more additional parking charges in respect of additional periods.
  - (5) The ticket referred to in paragraph (3) of this Article shall be exhibited in the relevant position.
  - (6) No ticket other than that specified at paragraph (3) hereof, apart from any ticket or badge approved by the Council shall be exhibited on the vehicle.

**Parking/**

### **Parking Period**

7. (1) Subject to paragraph (2) hereof the parking period for which a vehicle may be left in a car park during charging hours shall be one of the periods specified for small vehicles at column 7, and for heavy vehicles at column 13 of the Schedule opposite to the name of the car park in which the vehicle is left.
- (2) A vehicle may be left in a car park during charging hours for more than one parking period and without removal of the vehicle therefrom, provided always that the sum of such periods shall not exceed the maximum period specified in respect of that car park in column 8, if the vehicle is a small vehicle, or column 14, if the vehicle is a heavy vehicle, of the said Part of the Schedule
8. (1) If a vehicle is left in a car park:-
- (a) during charging hours and subject to the provisions of Articles 19 and 34(1) and (2) of this Order without evidence of payment or, is left for more than the Parking period, a penalty charge shall be payable.
- (b) subject to the provisions of Article 34(3) of this Order, for more than 15 minutes, a penalty charge is payable.
- (2) In the case of a vehicle in respect of which a penalty charge may have become payable it shall be the duty of a person duly authorised in that behalf by the Council to attach to the vehicle in a conspicuous position a Penalty Charge Notice.

### **Payment of Penalty Charge**

9. (1) A penalty charge shall be paid to the Council either by cash, cheque, bankers' draft, money order or postal order or Debit or Credit card, which shall be delivered or sent by post or by Phone or online so as to reach the Perth and Kinross Council at the address shown on the Notice not later than 4.00pm on the fourteenth day following the day on which the penalty charge became payable. Provided that, if the said fourteenth day falls upon a day on which the Council's premises at the said address are closed, the period within which payment of the said charge shall be made to the Council shall be extended until 4.00pm on the next full day on which the said premises are open for business.
- (2) In the event of non-compliance with the provisions of paragraph (1) hereof the person responsible shall be the owner of the vehicle in respect of which the charge was payable.

### **Restriction on Removal of Notices and Tickets**

10. (1) When a ticket has been exhibited on a vehicle in accordance with the provisions of Article 6(5) of this Order no person, other than the driver of the vehicle, shall remove the ticket from the vehicle unless authorised to do so by the driver.
- (2) Where a Penalty Charge Notice has been attached to a vehicle in accordance with the provisions of Article 8(2) of this Order, no person, other than the driver of the vehicle or a Parking Attendant, shall remove the Notice from the vehicle unless authorised to do so by the driver.

### **Indications by Tickets**

11. (1) As Article 6 part 3(a) and 3(b) of this Order.
- (2) The expiry of the parking period for which a parking charge has been paid shall be indicated when there is exhibited on the vehicle a ticket issued in terms of paragraph (1) hereof and the clock on the ticket issuing machine from which the said ticket was issued shows a time which indicates that a period in excess of the said parking period has elapsed.
- (3) The expiry of a parking period shall be indicated when there is exhibited on the vehicle a ticket issued/

issued in terms of paragraph (1) hereof and the day and the time shown on the clock on the ticket issuing machine from which the said ticket was issued indicate or indicates that the parking period purchased has elapsed.

#### **Indications by Ticket Issuing Machines and Tickets as Evidence**

12. (1) If at any time while a vehicle is left in a car park during charging hours no ticket is exhibited on that vehicle in accordance with the provisions of paragraph (1) of the last preceding Article it shall be presumed, unless the contrary is proved, that a parking charge has not been duly paid.
- (2) If at any time while a vehicle is left in a car park during charging hours the clock on the ticket issuing machine relating to the car park in which the vehicle is left and from which the ticket exhibited on the vehicle has been issued and the ticket exhibited on the vehicle gives the indication mentioned in paragraph (2) of the last preceding Article, it shall be presumed, unless the contrary is proved, that a parking charge has been duly paid and that the appropriate parking period has expired.
- (3) If at any time while a vehicle is left in a car park during charging hours the clock on the ticket issuing machine relating to the car park in which the vehicle is left and from which the ticket exhibited on the vehicle has been issued, and the ticket exhibited on the vehicle, gives the indication mentioned in paragraph (3) of the last preceding Article it shall be presumed, unless the contrary is proved, that the parking charge has been duly paid and that the appropriate parking period has expired.

#### **Interval Before Vehicle Again to be Left**

13. No vehicle which has been taken away from a parking space in a car park to which charging hours apply shall, until the expiration of one hour from the time it was taken away, be left again in that car park during charging hours.

#### **Season Tickets**

14. (1) Any person may apply to the Council for the issue of a season ticket for the purpose of permitting a specified small vehicle to be left in a car park named in the Schedule to this Order if a season ticket charge is specified in column 9 of the said part of the Schedule opposite to the name or names of the car park or parks in respect of which such a ticket is sought, and, subject to the provisions of this Article, the Council may at their discretion issue a season ticket on such conditions as they see fit.
- (2) The season ticket charge payable and the terms for which the season ticket is valid shall be the sum specified in column 9 and the terms specified in column 10 respectively in the said Part of the Schedule opposite to the name or names of the car park or car parks in respect of which a ticket is sought.
- (3) A season ticket issued in terms of this Article will bear the following particulars:-
  - (a) the registration mark of the vehicle in respect of which it is issued;
  - (b) the calendar month for which the ticket is issued;
  - (c) an authentication that the permit has been issued by the Council; and
  - (d) the identification of a car park or car parks in which a vehicle displaying the season ticket may be left.
- (4) A car park in which a vehicle on which a season ticket is displayed may be left in terms of this Article will be indicated by the specification of an identification in column 11 of the Schedule opposite/

opposite to its name.

- (5) A vehicle on which a season ticket is displayed shall not be left in a car park in exercise of the provisions of this Article unless the identification borne by the season ticket and the identification referred to at paragraph (3) hereof are the same.
- (6) A vehicle in respect of which a season ticket has been issued by the Council and which is left in a car park to which the ticket relates shall be exempt from the payment of any parking charge and subject to the provisions of Article 4(c) of this Order from compliance with any limitations of time during which a vehicle may be left in a car park but otherwise all the provisions of this Order shall apply to such a vehicle.
- (7) Upon leaving a vehicle in respect of which a season ticket has been issued by the Council in a car park to which the ticket relates the driver of the vehicle shall display the season ticket upon the vehicle in the relevant position.
- (8) Notwithstanding the provisions of the paragraphs (1) and (2) hereof the Council may at their discretion issue without charge to their employees a season ticket for use only when the person to whom it is issued requires to leave the vehicle in respect of which it is issued in a car park for a purpose directly associated with the exercise of local authority functions.

#### **Residents' Parking Permits**

15. A vehicle on which a residents' parking permit, issued and defined in terms of the Perth and Kinross Council (Perth Traffic Management) Order 2005 for use in on-street parking places, is displayed in the relevant position and which is left in a car park shall be exempt from the payment of any parking charge and, subject to the provisions of Article 4(c) hereof, from compliance with any limitation of time during which a vehicle may be left in a car park but otherwise all the provisions of this Order shall apply to such a vehicle.

#### **Large Passenger Vehicle Parking Permits**

16. (1) The Council may at their discretion issue a Large Passenger Vehicle Parking Permit to any operator of a large passenger vehicle on such conditions as they see fit, and may cancel a permit if any of these conditions are, in their view, not being complied with;
- (2) A large passenger vehicle for which a Large Passenger Vehicle Parking Permit has been issued, and which is left in any car park specified in the Schedule, shall be exempt from the payment of any charge and, subject to the provisions of Article 4(c) hereof, from compliance with any limitations of time during which a vehicle may be left in a car park but otherwise all the provisions of this Order shall apply to such large passenger vehicle.

#### **Servicing Area Parking Permit**

17. (1) The Council may at their discretion issue or cause to be issued Servicing Area Parking Permits to any vehicle on such conditions as they see fit, and may cancel a Permit if any of these conditions are, in their view, not being complied with.
- (2) Vehicles parking in a Servicing Area shall at all times display a Servicing Area Parking Permit valid for that servicing area.

#### **Manner of Standing in Car Parks**

18. (1) Subject to the provisions of paragraphs (2) and (3) hereof and Article 34 of this Order, every vehicle other than a heavy vehicle, left in a car park shall so stand that every part of the vehicle is within the limits of a marked parking space in such a car park and no vehicle shall be left in a car park other than within the limits of a marked parking space. In any other car park no vehicle shall be left in such a position that the movement of other vehicles is obstructed.
- (2) Subject to paragraph (3) hereof and Article 34 of this Order a heavy vehicle left in a car park shall so stand that every part of such vehicle is within the limits of two adjacent parking spaces and/

and parallel to their longitudinal axes: Provided always that where the dimensions of the vehicle preclude its being left in a manner specified herein it shall be left either under the direction of a person duly authorised in that behalf by the Council, or in such a position that the movement of other vehicles is not obstructed.

- (3) Where a reserved area for heavy vehicles is provided in any car park -
  - (a) no heavy vehicle shall be left in that car park, except within the reserved area, and
  - (b) no small vehicle shall be left in that car park within the reserved area unless the driver of the vehicle is otherwise directed by a person duly authorised in that behalf by the Council.

#### **Exemptions from Parking Charges and Time Limits**

19. (1) If at the time when a vehicle is left during charging hours in a car park there are on all of the ticket issuing machines relating to that car park Notices placed by any person duly authorised by the Council indicating that the ticket issuing machines are out of order, that vehicle shall be exempt from the parking charge provided that it is removed within a period not exceeding the maximum charging period for that car park after the first of the ticket issuing machines relating to that car park is rectified. If the vehicle is not removed within that period the maximum parking charge for that car park shall be treated as having been incurred and paid at the time that the first of the ticket issuing machines relating to that car park is rectified and all the provisions of this Order shall apply accordingly.
- (2) Subject to Article 4(c) of this Order the following vehicles left in parking spaces in car parks during the charging hours shall be exempt from the payment of any charge or from compliance with any limitation of time during which a vehicle may be left in a car park:-
  - (i) is being driven by a blue badge holder;
  - (ii) is being used for carrying the blue badge holder as a passenger;
  - (iii) is being used by an organisation for the conveyance of a blue badge holder;
  - (iv) a vehicle left by the driver thereof who is a general medical practitioner or a nurse/midwife and on which is displayed in the relevant position a badge recognised by the Council, while visiting patients on professional calls;
  - (v) a small vehicle upon which a season ticket or a residents' parking permit is displayed as provided for by Articles 14 and 15 respectively of this Order.
- (3) Without prejudice to the generality of this Article, the driver of a vehicle to which this Article applies shall cause the vehicle to wait in a parking space in a car park in accordance with the provisions of Article 18(1) of this Order.

#### **Removal of Vehicle from Parking Place**

20. (1) Where a person duly authorised in that behalf by the Council is of the opinion that any of the provisions contained in Articles 3, 4, 13, 14, 15, 16, 18, 19, 22, 23, 24, 26, 27 or 28 of the Order have been contravened or not complied with in respect of a vehicle left in a car park, they may remove the vehicle from the car park or cause it to be removed, and if it is so removed, shall provide for the safe custody of the vehicle.
- (2) The owner of the vehicle removed from the car park in terms of this Article shall be liable to pay the expenses of the Council incurred in respect of the removal and safekeeping of the vehicle.

#### **Movement of Vehicles in Parking Places in Emergencies**

21. (1) Any person duly authorised in that behalf by the Council may move or remove or cause to be moved or removed in case of emergency, or in contravention of Article 18 of this Order, to any place/



place they think fit, any vehicle left in a car park.

- (2) The owner of a vehicle moved in a car park due to contravention, in respect of that vehicle, of Article 18 of this Order, shall be liable to pay the expenses of the Council incurred in respect of moving the vehicle.

### **Restrictions on Use of Car Parks**

22. When in or near any car park, signs are erected or surface markings are laid down for the purpose of indicating the entrance or exit thereof, a specified direction of travel, an area of the car park which is to be kept clear of vehicles, or for any other purpose, no person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven or shall leave any vehicle other than in accordance with the instructions indicated by means of the said signs or markings.
23. No person shall use any car park or any vehicle left therein or shall cause a vehicle to wait in a car park:-
- (i) in connection with the sale of the vehicle;
  - (ii) in connection with the use of the vehicle for the advertising, retail selling or hiring of any skill, service or article: Provided that nothing in this Article shall prevent the sale of goods from a vehicle if the vehicle is a small goods vehicle left in a car park in terms of Article 34(2)(g) of this Order and the goods are immediately delivered or taken into premises adjacent to the car park from which the sale is effected;
  - (iii) in connection with canvassing the public for political or electioneering purposes;
  - (iv) for the purpose of the transfer of goods to or from a heavy vehicle for trading, industrial or business purposes;
  - (v) for the purpose of cleaning or washing the vehicle; or
  - (vi) in order that repairs may be effected upon the vehicle, except for the purpose of enabling its removal from the car park.
24. No person shall sound the horn or other similar instrument of a vehicle within a car park except when about to change the position of the vehicle or to depart from the car park.
25. No person shall use a car park as a means of driving a vehicle from one street to another street unless authorised to do so by a person duly authorised in that behalf by the Council.
26. The person in charge of a motor vehicle in a car park shall stop the engine as soon as the vehicle is in position in the car park and shall not start the engine except when about to change the position of the vehicle or in order to depart from the car park.
27. No person shall, except with the permission of a person duly authorised by the Council, drive any vehicle in a car park other than for the purpose of leaving that vehicle in the car park in accordance with the provisions of this Order or for the purpose of departing from the car park provided always that nothing in this Article shall prevent any person from driving or causing any vehicle to be driven in a car park for the purpose of taking access to premises or ground adjoining or abutting on the car park to which vehicular access is not available from any public street or otherwise for the purpose of using a means of access provided by the Council in terms of Section 42 of the Act and in compliance with the terms of a written agreement between the Council and the occupier of such adjoining or abutting premises under the said Section of the Act.
28. The person in charge of a vehicle in a car park shall hold a valid licence to drive issued in terms of Part III of the Road Traffic Act 1988, and shall drive the vehicle in such a manner as is conducive to the safety of other persons and vehicles in the car park.
29. No person shall use any part of a car park or any vehicle left in a car park for sleeping, camping, or light or cause or permit to be lit any fire for cooking purposes.
30. No person shall erect or cause to be erected any tent, booth, stand, building or other structure in a car park/

park without the written consent of the Council.

31. No person shall enter or wilfully remain within a car park or part thereof which is suspended in terms of Article 35 of this Order.
32. No person shall deposit or affix any advertising materials or leaflets to vehicles parked within a car park or on any structure situated within or forming part of a car park.
33. A person duly authorised in that behalf by the Council may require any person contravening any of the provisions contained in Articles 23 to 32 inclusive to leave a car park at once.

#### **Exemptions for Vehicles Waiting in Car Parks**

34. (1) Any person may cause a vehicle to wait without payment anywhere in a car park, other than a car park which has been designated as a Servicing Area or the use of which has been suspended, for a maximum period of five minutes at any time.
- (2) Any person may cause a vehicle to wait without payment anywhere in a car park other than a car park which has been designated as a Servicing Area or the use of which has been suspended, for a period greater than five minutes only if:-
  - (a) the vehicle is waiting owing to the driver being prevented from proceeding by circumstances beyond his control or to such waiting being necessary in order to avoid an accident;
  - (b) the vehicle is a vehicle used for fire brigade purposes or an ambulance or a vehicle in the service of a local authority or a vehicle in the service of a police force provided that the vehicle is being used in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
  - (c) the vehicle is waiting only for so long as may be reasonably necessary to enable it to be used for the purpose of facilitating the movement of traffic or promoting its safety;and, only if it is not causing an obstruction, if
  - (d) the vehicle is a passenger vehicle and is waiting only for so long as may be necessary to enable a person to board or alight therefrom or to load thereon or unload therefrom his personal luggage;
  - (e) the vehicle is waiting only for so long as may be reasonably necessary to enable it to be used for the purpose of any road works, building operations, demolition or excavations or for the construction, maintenance, repair or removal of any sewer or of any main, pipe, cable or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telegraphic line, traffic sign or ticket issuing machine within or adjacent to the car park or for the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the car park or, if the vehicle is waiting only for so long as is necessary to enable it to be used in connection with the posting or removing of advertising material in the form of posters on or from, in premises adjacent to the car park in which the vehicle is waiting;
  - (f) the vehicle, not being a passenger vehicle, is in actual use in connection with the removal of furniture from one office or dwellinghouse to another or the removal of furniture from such premises to a depository or to such premises from a depository;
  - (g) the vehicle, not being a passenger vehicle, is waiting for the purpose of loading or unloading goods at premises adjacent to the car park in which the vehicle is waiting and the vehicle does not wait for such purpose for more than thirty minutes or such longer period as a person duly authorised in that behalf by the Council;

and except in the circumstances described in the foregoing paragraphs of this Article no person/

person may leave a vehicle in a car park other than in accordance with the provisions of Article 18 of this Order.

- (3) Any person may cause a large passenger vehicle to wait without payment in a coach parking space in a car park other than a car park or part of a car park the use of which has been suspended provided that a large passenger vehicle shall not wait in such coach parking areas for a period of more than 15 minutes at any one time.
- (4) No charge specified in the foregoing provisions of this Order shall be payable in respect of any vehicle waiting in a car park in accordance with the foregoing provisions of this Article.

#### **Power to Suspend Use of Car Parks**

35. (1) Subject to Article 35(2) any person duly authorised in that behalf by the Council may suspend the use of a car park or any part thereof whenever and for such period and for such purposes as they may consider reasonable.
  - (2) Subject to Article 35(1) the Council in giving authority for a person to suspend a car park space may charge that person a sum calculated at a rate equal to the daily rate per space suspended. In the event of that person refusing or delaying to pay, the Council has the right to withdraw its authority.
  - (3) Any person suspending the use of a car park or any part thereof in accordance with the provisions of the immediately preceding paragraph shall place or cause to be placed in or adjacent to that car park or the relevant part thereof a traffic sign or traffic signs indicating that waiting is prohibited.
  - (4) No person shall cause or permit a vehicle to be left in any part of a car park during such period as there is in or adjacent to that part of the car park a traffic sign placed in pursuance of the immediately preceding paragraph: provided that nothing in this paragraph shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle being used for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes to be left in any part of a car park during such period as is referred to in this paragraph, or any other vehicle to be so left if that vehicle is left with the permission of the person suspending the use of the car park or part thereof in pursuance of paragraph (1) above.
36. The Council may:-
    - (a) install in such positions in or in the vicinity of a car park as they may think fit such ticket issuing machines as are required by this Order for the purposes of that car park; and
    - (b) carry out such other work as is authorised by this Order or is reasonably required for the purposes of the satisfactory operation of a car park.
  37. Any event of non-compliance with a provision of this Order shall constitute a contravention against that provision of the Order. This may result in the issue of a Penalty Charge Notice.

#### **PART IV REVOCATION**

38. The Perth and Kinross Council (Off-Street Car Parks) Order 1999 is hereby revoked.
