PERTH AND KINROSS COUNCIL (MILNATHORT TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT) (VARIATION) (NO 1) ORDER 2013

(NO/06/13)

Perth and Kinross Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Sections 1, 2, 3, 4 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (which Act of 1984 is hereinafter referred to as "the Act") and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf and after consultation with the Chief Constable in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby make the following Order:-

- 1 This Order may be cited as the "Perth and Kinross Council (Milnathort Traffic Management) (Variation) (No 1) Order 2013" and shall come into operation on the Twenty-eighth day of March Two thousand and thirteen.
- 2 The Perth and Kinross Council (Milnathort Traffic Management) Order 2000 is hereby varied and shall henceforth have effect subject to the amendments thereto specified and described in the Schedule to this Order.

PERTH AND KINROSS COUNCIL (MILNATHORT TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT) (VARIATION) (NO 1) ORDER 2013

The Schedule to the "Perth and Kinross Council (Milnathort Traffic Management) Order 2000" requires to be varied as follows:-

1. At PART II, NO WAITING AT ANY TIME, after 5. NEW ROAD insert the following:-

5A. PERTH ROAD

North side thereof from its junction with the extended east kerbline of Victoria Avenue eastwards for a distance of 30 metres or thereby

2. At PART II, NO WAITING AT ANY TIME, delete the existing wording at 8. VICTORIA AVENUE and substitute with the following:-

Both sides thereof from its junction with New Road/Perth Road northwestwards for a distance of 25 metres or thereby.

Council Reasons

Due to the concerns of local residents the Council wish to install No Waiting at Any Time restrictions at Perth Road and Victoria Avenue, Milnathort to alleviate indiscriminate parking and to improve the safety of pedestrians in this area.
