PERTH AND KINROSS COUNCIL (BANKFOOT TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT) (VARIATION) (NO 1) ORDER 2013

(NO/18/13)

Perth and Kinross Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Sections 1(1) and (2), 2(1) to (3) and 4(2) of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (which Act of 1984 is hereinafter referred to as "the Act") and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf and after consultation with the Chief Constable in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby make the following Order:-

- This Order may be cited as the "Perth and Kinross Council (Bankfoot Traffic Management) (Variation) (No 1) Order 2013" and shall come into operation on the Second day of November Two thousand and thirteen.
- The "Perth and Kinross Council (Bankfoot Traffic Management) Order 2013" is hereby varied and shall henceforth have effect subject to the amendments thereto specified and described in the Schedule to this Order.

PERTH AND KINROSS COUNCIL (BANKFOOT TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT) (VARIATION) (NO 1) ORDER 2013

The Schedule to the "Perth and Kinross Council (Bankfoot Traffic Management) Order 2013" requires to be varied as follows:-

At **PART I, ONE WAY STREETS**, delete the existing and substitute with the following:-

COLUMN 1

Church Lane between its junction with Cross Street and Prieston Road.

COLUMN 2

Southwards from Cross Street towards Prieston Road.

Council Reasons

The Council wish to revoke the One Way system to ensure that all vehicles can enter and exit the area on adopted roads without the risk of large vehicles causing damage to buildings on Church Lane. It is proposed that the part of the Road Traffic Order for Bankfoot relating to one-way traffic in Newhall Street and Cross Street should be revoked. The section of the Road Traffic Order relating to one-way traffic in Church Lane will remain in force.
