(TOWN OF AYR) (WAITING RESTRICTIONS) (CIVIL ENFORCEMENT) ORDER 2012

South Ayrshire Council in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 3, 4, 32, 35, 45, 99, 101, 102, 124 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, the Road Traffic (Permitted Parking Area and Special Parking Area) (South Ayrshire Council) Designation Order 2012 and the Road Traffic Act 1991 and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Constable of Strathclyde Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following Order:-

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the "South Ayrshire Council (Town of Ayr) (Waiting Restrictions) (Civil Enforcement) Order 2012" and shall come into operation on Saturday 1st September 2012.

Interpretation

2. In this Order the following expressions have the meanings hereby assigned to them:-

"the 1984 Act" means the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984;

"the 1991 Act" means the Road Traffic Act 1991;

"bus" means -

- (i) a motor vehicle constructed or adapted to carry 8 or more passengers (exclusive of the driver);
- (ii) a local bus not so constructed or adapted;

"disabled person's badge" has the same meaning as in the Disabled Persons ('badges for Motor Vehicles) (Scotland) Regulations 2000, as amended;

"disabled person's vehicle" has the same meaning as in the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (Scotland) Regulations 2000;

"dual purpose vehicle" has the same meaning as in Regulation 3(2) of the Road Vehicles (Construction and Use) Regulations 1986 as originally enacted;

"emergency service vehicles" means a vehicle being used by the Police, Fire Brigade or Ambulance Services in an emergency;

"goods vehicle" means a vehicle constructed or adapted for the use for the conveyance of goods or burden of any description, but not including a dual purpose vehicle;

[&]quot;the Council" means South Ayrshire Council;

"local authority" means the South Ayrshire Council;

"local roads authority" means the South Ayrshire Council;

"local service" has the same meaning as in the Transport Act 1985;

"motor-cycle" has the same meaning as that in Section 136 of the 1984 Act;

"owner" in relation to a vehicle, means the person by whom such vehicle is kept and used. In determining who was the owner at any time it shall be presumed that the owner was the person named in the vehicle registration document as the registered keeper of the vehicle or the person who has the use of such vehicle in the course of his/her employment and who is entitled to use such vehicle as though he/she were the registered keeper thereof;

"parking attendant" means a person employed in accordance with Section 63A of the 1984 Act to carry out the functions therein;

"parking bay" means the area of a road within a parking place which is provided for the leaving of a vehicle and is indicated in such a manner as the local roads authority may determine by signs, carriageway markings, lines or other indications;

"parking place" means an area of a road designated by this Order for the waiting of vehicles of specific classes and indicated on the carriageway by markings in accordance with the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002;

"pedal cycle" means a unicycle, bicycle, tricycle or cycle having four or more wheels, not being in any case mechanically propelled unless it is an electrically assisted pedal cycle of such class as is to be treated as not being a motor vehicle for the purposes of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984;

"penalty charge" has the same meaning as in Section 82(1) of the 1991 Act;

"penalty charge notice" means a notice issued or served by a parking attendant pursuant to the provisions of Section 66 of the 1991 Act;

'private hire car' has the same meaning as in Section 23(1) of the Civic Government (Scotland) Act 1982

"public service vehicle" has the same meaning as in the Public Passenger Vehicles Act 1981;

"taxi" has the same meaning as in Section 23(1) of the Civic Government (Scotland) Act 1982;

"vehicle" unless the context otherwise requires, means a vehicle of any description and includes a machine or implement of any kind drawn or propelled along roads, whether or not by mechanical power;

3. Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended by any subsequent enactment.

4. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies to an Act of Parliament.

Prohibition of Waiting and Loading (Schedules 1 – 8)

- 5. Save as provided in Article 11 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a parking attendant in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to wait at any time in any of the lengths of road specified in Schedule 1 to this Order.
- 6. Save as provided in Article 12 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a parking attendant in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to wait at any time in any of the lengths of roads specified in Schedule 2 to this Order.
- 7. Save as provided in Article 12 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a parking attendant in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to wait between the hours of 7.00am and 7.00pm, Monday to Sunday, inclusive, in any of the lengths of roads specified in Schedule 3 to this Order.
- 8. Save as provided in Article 12 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a parking attendant in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to wait between the hours of 6.00pm and 6.00am, Monday to Sunday, inclusive, in any of the lengths of roads specified in Schedule 4 to this Order.
- 9. Save as provided in Article 12 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a parking attendant in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to wait between the hours of 6.00pm and 4.00am, Monday to Sunday inclusive, in any of the lengths of roads specified in Schedule 5 to this Order.
- 10. Save as provided in Article 12 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a parking attendant in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to wait between the hours of midnight and 4.00am, Monday to Sunday inclusive, in any of the lengths of roads specified in Schedule 6 to this Order.
- 11. Nothing in Article 5 of this Order shall -
 - (a) prevent any person from causing or permitting a vehicle to wait in any of the lengths of the roads referred to in those Articles -

- (i) for so long as is necessary to enable a person to board or alight from the vehicle or to load thereon or unload therefrom his personal luggage;
- (ii) for so long as may be necessary to enable the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of any of the said lengths of the roads so referred to, or the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or near to any of the said lengths of roads, of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity, or of any telecommunications apparatus as defined in the Telecommunications Act 1984;
- (iii) for so long as may be necessary to enable the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purposes in any other road, to be used in pursuance of statutory powers and duties and in particular, but without prejudice to the generality of the foregoing, to enable the vehicle to be used in connection with police, fire brigade and ambulance purposes:
- (iv) if the vehicle is waiting owing to the driver being prevented from proceeding by circumstances beyond his control or to such waiting being necessary in order to avoid an accident;
- (v) if the vehicle is in the service of or employed by the Post Office and is waiting in any of the lengths of the roads while the postal packets addressed to premises adjacent thereto are being unloaded from the vehicle or having been unloaded therefrom are being delivered or while postal packets are being collected from premises or posting boxes adjacent thereto;
- (vi) for the purpose of loading or unloading the vehicle while the vehicle is standing at the kerb and is in actual use in connection with the removal of furniture from such premises to a depository or to such premises from a depository;
- (vii) to enable the vehicle to be used in connection with funeral operations and weddings.
- (b) notwithstanding anything in paragraph (a) of this Article, the driver of a vehicle waiting shall move the said vehicle on the instruction of a police constable in uniform or a parking attendant in uniform, whenever such moving may be reasonably necessary for the purpose of preventing an obstruction or danger to others.
- 12. (1) Nothing in Articles 6, 7, 8, 9 and 10 of this Order shall -
 - (a) prevent any person from causing or permitting a vehicle to wait in any of the lengths of the roads referred to in those Articles -
 - (i) for so long as may be necessary to enable the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in

connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of any of the said lengths of the roads so referred to, or the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or near to any of the said lengths of roads, of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity, or of any telecommunications apparatus as defined in the Telecommunications Act 1984;

- (ii) for so long as may be necessary to enable the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purposes in any other road, to be used in pursuance of statutory powers and duties and in particular, but without prejudice to the generality of the foregoing, to enable the vehicle to be used in connection with police, fire brigade and ambulance purposes;
- (iii) if the vehicle is waiting owing to the driver being prevented from proceeding by circumstances beyond his control or to such waiting being necessary in order to avoid an accident;
- (b) apply to a taxi.
- (c) notwithstanding anything in paragraphs (a) and (b) of this Article, the driver of a vehicle waiting shall move the said vehicle on the instruction of a police constable in uniform or a parking attendant in uniform, whenever such moving may be reasonably necessary for the purpose of preventing an obstruction or danger to others.
- (2) Articles 6, 7, 8, 9 and 10 shall apply to private hire cars
- 13. Save as provided in Articles 15, 18 and 19 of this Order no person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any vehicle other than a pedal cycle so as to enter, proceed or wait, between the hours of 10.30am and 4.30pm Monday to Sunday inclusive, in any of the lengths of roads specified in Schedule 7 to this Order.
- 14. Save as provided in Articles 15, 16, 17, 18 and 19 of this Order no person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any vehicle other than a pedal cycle so as to enter, proceed or wait, between the hours of Midnight and 10.30am, Monday to Sunday inclusive, and between the hours of 4.30pm and Midnight, Monday to Sunday inclusive, in any lengths of roads specified in Schedule 7 to this Order.
- 15. Nothing in Articles 13 or 14 of this Order shall apply so as to prevent any vehicle from being driven so as to enter, proceed or wait in any of the lengths of roads referred to in those Articles provided that -
 - (a) it is a vehicle in the service of the Post Office;
 - (b) if the vehicle is a hand cart or barrow or an electrically or mechanically propelled vehicle which is under the control of a pedestrian and is being used for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or postal packets to or from premises or posting boxes adjacent to the road to enable the vehicle to wait

while postal packets addressed to premises adjacent thereto are being unloaded from the vehicle or having been unload therefrom are being delivered or while postal packets are being collected from premises or postal boxes adjacent thereto.

- Nothing in Article 14 of this Order shall apply so as to prevent any goods vehicle from being driven so as to enter, proceed or wait in any of the lengths of roads referred to in that Article provided that no vehicle engaged in delivering or collecting goods or merchandise or being loaded or unloaded shall wait for a longer period than 30 minutes in the same place and no such vehicle shall wait for a longer period than 10 minutes in the same place without goods being loaded onto or unloaded from the vehicle.
- 17. Nothing in Article 14 of this Order shall apply so as to prevent any vehicle from being driven so as to enter, proceed or wait in any of the lengths of roads referred to in that Article provided that -
 - (a) no vehicle will be driven in any of the lengths of roads referred to in that Article unless there is displayed on the windscreen of the vehicle a permit issued by the Chief Constable or by an officer authorised by the Executive Director of Development & Environment indicating that that vehicle is authorised to be used in the said road; and
 - (b) the driver of any vehicle referred to in sub-paragraph (a) hereof on which a permit is displayed shall comply with any condition attached to the issue of the permit by the Chief Constable or an officer authorised by the Executive Director of Development & Environment including, without prejudice to the generality of the foregoing, any condition regarding the time or times during which the permit may be used and the part of the said roads on which the vehicle may be driven or allowed to wait.
- Nothing in Articles 13 or 14 of this Order shall apply so as to prevent any disabled person's vehicle which displays in the relevant position a disabled person's badge issued by a local authority in exercise of its powers under Section 21(1) of the Chronically Sick and Disabled Persons Act 1970 from being driven so as to enter, proceed or wait in any of the lengths of roads referred to in those Articles provided that no such vehicle shall wait except on a part of the road at which the local roads authority have caused to be erected or placed a traffic sign or signs indicating that that part of the road is a disabled person's parking space.
- 19. Nothing in Articles 13 or 14 of this Order shall apply so as to prevent a vehicle from being driven so as to enter, proceed or wait in any lengths of roads referred to in those Articles provided that the vehicle is -
 - (a) a vehicle being used in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of any of the said lengths of the roads so referred to, or the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or near to any of the said lengths of roads, of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas,

- water or electricity, or of any telecommunications apparatus as defined in the Telecommunications Act 1984;
- (b) a vehicle being used in pursuance of statutory powers and duties and in particular, but without prejudice to the generality of the foregoing, a vehicle being used in connection with police, fire brigade and ambulance purposes;
- (c) a principal vehicle being used in connection with weddings and funerals.
- 20. Notwithstanding anything in Articles 15, 16, 17, 18 and 19, the driver of a vehicle waiting shall move the said vehicle on the instruction of a police constable in uniform or a parking attendant in uniform, whenever such moving may be reasonably necessary for the purpose of preventing an obstruction or danger to others.

Prohibition of Waiting (Schedules 9 – 14)

- Save as provided in Articles 27, 28 and 29 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a parking attendant in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to wait at any time in any of the lengths of road specified in Schedules 8 and 9 to this Order.
- 22. Save as provided in Articles 27, 28 and 29 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a parking attendant in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to wait between the hours of 6.00am and 6.00pm, Monday to Sunday inclusive, in any of the lengths of road specified in Schedule 10 to this Order.
- 23. Save as provided in Articles 27, 28 and 29 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a parking attendant in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to wait between the hours of 8.00am and 6.00pm, Monday to Sunday inclusive, in any of the lengths of road specified in Schedule 11 to this Order.
- Save as provided in Articles 27, 28 and 29 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a parking attendant in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to wait between the hours of 8.00am and 6.00pm, Monday to Saturday inclusive, in any of the lengths of road specified in Schedule 12 to this Order.
- 25. Save as provided in Articles 27, 28 and 29 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a parking attendant in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to wait between the hours of 8.15am and 7.00pm, Monday to Sunday inclusive, in any of the lengths of road specified in Schedule 13 to this Order.

- 26. Save as provided in Articles 27, 28 and 29 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a parking attendant in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to wait between the hours of 8.30am and 5.30pm, Monday to Sunday inclusive, in any of the lengths of road specified in Schedule 14 to this Order.
- 27. Nothing in Articles 21, 22, 23, 24, 25, and 26 of this Order shall -
 - (a) prevent any person from causing or permitting a vehicle to wait in any of the lengths of the roads referred to in those Articles -
 - (i) for so long as is necessary to enable a person to board or alight from the vehicle or to load thereon or unload therefrom his personal luggage;
 - (ii) for so long as may be necessary to enable the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of any of the said lengths of the roads so referred to, or the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or near to any of the said lengths of roads, of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity, or of any telecommunications apparatus as defined in the Telecommunications Act 1984;
 - (iii) for so long as may be necessary to enable the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purposes in any other road, to be used in pursuance of statutory powers and duties and in particular, but without prejudice to the generality of the foregoing, to enable the vehicle to be used in connection with police, fire brigade and ambulance purposes;
 - (iv) if the vehicle is waiting owing to the driver being prevented from proceeding by circumstances beyond his control or to such waiting being necessary in order to avoid an accident;
 - (v) if the vehicle is in the service of or employed by the Post Office and is waiting in any of the lengths of the roads while the postal packets addressed to premises adjacent thereto are being unloaded from the vehicle or having been unloaded therefrom are being delivered or while postal packets are being collected from premises or posting boxes adjacent thereto;
 - (vi) for the purpose of loading or unloading the vehicle while the vehicle is standing at the kerb and is in actual use in connection with the removal of furniture from such premises to a depository or to such premises from a depository;
 - (vii) to enable the vehicle to be used in connection with funeral operations and weddings.
 - (b) notwithstanding anything in paragraph (a) of this Article, the driver of a vehicle waiting shall move the said vehicle on the instruction of a police constable in uniform or a parking attendant in uniform, whenever such moving may be

reasonably necessary for the purpose of preventing an obstruction or danger to others.

- Nothing in Articles 21, 22, 23, 24, 25, and 26 of this Order shall apply to any disabled person's vehicle which is not causing an obstruction and which displays a disabled person's badge issued by a local authority in exercise of its powers under Section 21 of the Chronically Sick and Disabled Persons Act 1970, provided that
 - (a) no such vehicle shall wait between the hours of 8.30am and 9.30am, 12.30pm and 2.00pm, and 4.30pm and 5.30pm, Monday to Saturday inclusive, in any lengths of roads specified in Schedule 8 to this Order.
 - (b) notwithstanding anything in paragraph (a) of this Article, the driver of a vehicle waiting shall move the said vehicle on the instruction of a police constable in uniform or a parking attendant in uniform, whenever such moving may be reasonably necessary for the purpose of preventing an obstruction or danger to others.
- 29. Nothing in Articles 21, 22, 23, 24, 25, and 26 of this Order shall prevent any person from causing or permitting a vehicle to wait at the kerb in any of the lengths of the roads referred to in those articles -
 - (a) for so long as may be necessary for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or merchandise or loading or unloading the vehicle at premises adjoining that road provided that
 - (i) no vehicle engaged in delivering or collecting goods or merchandise or being loaded or unloaded shall wait for a longer period than thirty minutes in the same place and no such vehicle shall wait for a longer period than 10 minutes in the same place without goods being loaded onto or unloaded from the vehicle; and
 - (ii) no such vehicle shall wait between the hours of 8.30am and 9.30am, 12.30pm and 2.00pm, and 4.30pm and 5.30pm, Monday to Saturday inclusive in any of the lengths of roads specified in Schedule 8 to this Order.
 - (b) notwithstanding anything in paragraph (a) of this Article, the driver of a vehicle waiting for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or merchandise or loading or unloading the vehicle shall move the same on the instruction of a police constable in uniform or a parking attendant in uniform, whenever such moving may be reasonably necessary for the purpose of preventing an obstruction.

Limited Waiting (Schedules 15 – 18)

30. Save as provided in Articles 34, 35 and 36 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a parking

attendant in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to wait between the hours of 8.00am and 6.00pm, Monday to Sunday inclusive, in any of the lengths of roads specified in Schedule 15 to this Order-

- (a) for a longer period than 30 minutes; or
- (b) if a period of less than 30 minutes has elapsed since the last period of waiting of the vehicle in any of the said lengths of road.
- Save as provided in Articles 34, 35 and 36 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a parking attendant in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to wait between the hours of 8.00am and 6.00pm, Monday to Saturday inclusive, in any of the areas of roads specified in column 2 of Schedule 16 to this Order-
 - (a) for a longer period than 30 minutes; or
 - (b) if a period of less than 60 minutes has elapsed since the last period of waiting of the vehicle in the same parking place.
- 32. Save as provided in Articles 34, 35 and 36 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a parking attendant in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to wait between the hours of 8.00am and 6.00pm, Monday to Saturday inclusive, in any of the areas of roads specified in column 2 of Schedule 17 to this Order-
 - (a) for a longer period than 60 minutes; or
 - (b) if a period of less than 60 minutes has elapsed since the last period of waiting of the vehicle in the same parking place.
- 33. Save as provided in Articles 34, 35 and 36 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a parking attendant in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to wait between the hours of 8.00am and 6.00pm, Monday to Saturday inclusive, in any of the areas of roads specified in column 2 of Schedule 18 to this Order-
 - (a) for a longer period than 3 hours; or
 - (b) if a period of less than 60 minutes has elapsed since the last period of waiting of the vehicle in the same parking place.
- 34. Nothing in Articles 30, 31, 32 and 33 of this Order shall -
 - (a) prevent any person from causing or permitting a vehicle to wait in any of the lengths of the roads referred to in those Articles -
 - (i) for so long as is necessary to enable a person to board or alight from the vehicle or to load thereon or unload therefrom his personal luggage;

- (ii) for so long as may be necessary to enable the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of any of the said lengths of the roads so referred to, or the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or near to any of the said lengths of roads, of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity, or of any telecommunications apparatus as defined in the Telecommunications Act 1984;
- (iii) for so long as may be necessary to enable the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purposes in any other road, to be used in pursuance of statutory powers and duties and in particular, but without prejudice to the generality of the foregoing, to enable the vehicle to be used in connection with police, fire brigade and ambulance purposes;
- (iv) if the vehicle is waiting owing to the driver being prevented from proceeding by circumstances beyond his control or to such waiting being necessary in order to avoid an accident;
- (v) if the vehicle is in the service of or employed by the Post Office and is waiting in any of the lengths of the roads while the postal packets addressed to premises adjacent thereto are being unloaded from the vehicle or having been unloaded therefrom are being delivered or while postal packets are being collected from premises or posting boxes adjacent thereto;
- (vi) for the purpose of loading or unloading the vehicle while the vehicle is standing at the kerb and is in actual use in connection with the removal of furniture from such premises to a depository or to such premises from a depository;
- (vii) to enable the vehicle to be used in connection with funeral operations and weddings.
- (b) notwithstanding anything in paragraph (a) of this Article, the driver of a vehicle waiting for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or merchandise or loading or unloading the vehicle shall move the same on the instruction of a police constable in uniform or a parking attendant in uniform, whenever such moving may be reasonably necessary for the purpose of preventing an obstruction.
- Nothing in Articles 30, 31, 32 and 33 of this Order shall apply to any disabled person's vehicle which is not causing an obstruction and which displays a disabled person's badge issued by a local authority in exercise of its powers under Section 21 of the Chronically Sick and Disabled Persons Act 1970 notwithstanding, the driver of a vehicle waiting shall move the said vehicle on the instruction of a police constable in uniform or a parking attendant in uniform, whenever such moving may be reasonably necessary for the purpose of preventing an obstruction or danger to others.

- 36. Nothing in Articles 30, 31, 32 and 33 of this Order shall prevent any person from causing or permitting a vehicle to wait at the kerb in any of the lengths of the roads referred to in those articles -
 - (a) for so long as may be necessary for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or merchandise or loading or unloading the vehicle at premises adjoining that road provided that no vehicle engaged in delivering or collecting goods or merchandise or being loaded or unloaded shall wait for a longer period than thirty minutes in the same place and no such vehicle shall wait for a longer period than 10 minutes in the same place without goods being loaded onto or unloaded from the vehicle; and
 - (b) notwithstanding anything in paragraph (a) of this Article, the driver of a vehicle waiting for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or merchandise or loading or unloading the vehicle shall move the same on the instruction of a police constable in uniform or a parking attendant in uniform, whenever such moving may be reasonably necessary for the purpose of preventing an obstruction.

Alteration of Position of a Vehicle

37. Where any vehicle is standing in contravention of the provisions of Articles 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 13, 14, 21, 22, 23, 24, 25, 26, 30, 31, 32 and 33, a police constable in uniform, a parking attendant in uniform, or a person duly authorised by the Council may alter, or cause to be altered, the position of the vehicle in order that the manner of standing of the said vehicle shall comply with the aforementioned provisions.

Removal of a Vehicle

38. Where a police constable in uniform, a parking attendant in uniform, or a person duly authorised by the Council is of the opinion that any of the provisions contained in Articles 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 13, 14, 21, 22, 23, 24, 25, 26, 30, 31, 32 and 33, have been contravened or have not been complied with in respect of a vehicle left in a length of road described by this Order, he or she may remove the vehicle, or cause the vehicle to be removed, from the length of road and, where it is so removed, shall provide for the safe custody of the vehicle.

Movement of a Vehicle in an emergency

39. Any person duly authorised by the Council, or a police constable in uniform or a parking attendant in uniform, may move or cause to be moved, in case of an emergency, to any place they think fit, any vehicles left in any length of road described by this Order.

Designated Disabled Persons Parking Places (Schedules 19 – 20)

- 40. Each area of a road which is designated in Column 2 of Schedule 19 to this Order is hereby designated as a disabled persons parking place.
- 41. Each area of a road which is designated in Column 2 of Schedule 20 to this Order is hereby designated as a disabled persons parking place.
- The disabled persons parking places designated in Article 40 of this Order shall only be used for the leaving, for a period not exceeding two hours, of disabled persons vehicles displaying a disabled persons badge issued by a local authority in exercise of its powers under Section 21 of the Chronically Sick and Disabled Persons Act 1970.
- 43. The disabled persons parking places designated in Article 41 of this Order shall be restricted to a maximum two hour stay between the hours of 6.00am and 6.00pm of disabled persons vehicles displaying a disabled persons badge issued by a local authority in exercise of its powers under Section 21 of the Chronically Sick and Disabled Persons Act 1970.
- 44. The number of parking bays in each disabled persons parking place shall not exceed the number specified in Column 3 of Schedules 19 and 20 to this Order.
- The limits of the disabled persons parking places designated in Articles 40 and 41 of this Order and the limits of each parking bay in a parking place shall be indicated on the carriageway in such a manner as the local roads authority may determine by signs, carriageway markings, lines or other indications.
- 46. Every disabled persons vehicle left in a parking place designated in Articles 40 and 41 of this Order shall so stand such that no bay is occupied by more than one disabled persons vehicle and that every part of the vehicle is within the limits of a parking bay provided that, where the length of a disabled persons vehicle precludes compliance with this paragraph, such disabled persons vehicle shall be deemed to be within the limits of a parking bay if -
 - (a) the extreme front portion, or, as the case may be, the extreme rear portion of the disabled persons vehicle is within 300mm of an indication on the carriageway provided under Article 45 of this Order in relation to the parking bay; and
 - (b) the disabled persons vehicle, or any part thereof, is not within the limits of any adjoining parking bay.

Where any vehicle is standing in a disabled persons parking place in contravention of the provisions of Articles 42 or 43, a police constable in uniform, a parking attendant in uniform, or a person duly authorised by the Council may alter, or cause to be altered, the position of the vehicle in order that the manner of standing of the said vehicle shall comply with the aforementioned provisions.

Removal of a Vehicle

Where a police constable in uniform, a parking attendant in uniform, or a person duly authorised by the Council is of the opinion that any of the provisions contained in Articles 42, 43 or 46 have been contravened or have not been complied with in respect of a vehicle left in a disabled persons parking place designated by this Order, he or she may remove the vehicle, or cause the vehicle to be removed, from the parking place and, where it is so removed, shall provide for the safe custody of the vehicle.

Movement of a Vehicle in an emergency

49. Any person duly authorised by the Council, or a police constable in uniform or a parking attendant in uniform, may move or cause to be moved in case of an emergency, to any place they think fit, disabled persons vehicles left in a parking place.

Power to suspend parking places

- 50. (a) Any person duly authorised by the Council may suspend the use of a parking place or any part thereof whenever such suspension is considered necessary -
 - (i) for the purpose of facilitating the movement of traffic or promoting its safety; or
 - (ii) for the purpose of any building operation, demolition or excavation in or adjacent to the parking place or the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the parking place or the laying, erection, alteration, removal or repair in or adjacent to the parking place of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telecommunication apparatus, traffic sign or parking ticket machine; or
 - (iii) for the convenience of occupiers of premises adjacent to the parking place on any occasion of the removal of furniture from one office or dwelling house to another or the removal of furniture from such premises to a depository or to such premises from a depository; or
 - (iv) on any occasion on which it is likely, by reason of some special attraction, that any street will be thronged or obstructed; or

- (v) for the convenience of occupiers of premises adjacent to the parking place at times of weddings or funerals, or on other special occasions.
- (c) A police constable in uniform may suspend for not longer than twenty four hours the use of a parking place or part thereof whenever such suspension is considered reasonably necessary for the purpose of facilitating the movement of traffic or promoting its safety.

Contraventions

- If a vehicle is left on any of the roads specified in any of the Schedules to this Order or any parking place without complying with the requirements of this Order, a contravention shall have occurred and a penalty charge shall be payable. A penalty Charge Notice showing the information required by the appropriate legislation may then be issued by a parking attendant in accordance with the requirements of the legislation or any subsequent applicable legislation or the vehicle may be removed from the location.
- The particulars given in the penalty charge notice attached to a vehicle in accordance with Article 51 shall be treated as evidence in any proceedings relating to failure to pay such penalty charge.
- Where a penalty charge notice has been attached to a vehicle in accordance with the provisions of Article 51 no person, not being the driver of the vehicle, a parking attendant in uniform, or some other person duly authorised by the Council, shall remove the notice from the vehicle unless authorised to do so by the owner of the vehicle.
- 54. Where a parking attendant has moved or removed, or caused to be moved or removed, a vehicle in accordance with Articles 38, 39, 48, 49 or 51 -
 - (a) he/she shall provide for the safe custody of the vehicle;
 - (b) the Council shall be entitled to recover from the person responsible such charges in respect of the removal, storage and disposal of the vehicle as it might prescribe from time to time;
 - (c) the provisions of the 1984 Act as amended shall apply to the disposal of such vehicles removed by or on behalf of the Council pursuant to this Article.

Abandoned Vehicles

- Subject to Article 56, the Council may as respects a vehicle which has been removed from any of the roads specified in any of the Schedules to this Order or any parking place in pursuance of Articles 38, 39, 48, 49 or 51, if it appears to them to have been abandoned, sell or otherwise dispose of the vehicle after having made reasonable enquiry to ascertain the name and address of the owner of the vehicle and to inform the owner of their intention.
- The Council will be deemed to have made reasonable enquiry to ascertain the name and address of the owner of any vehicle to which Article 55 applies provided that they have taken such steps in relation to that vehicle that may be prescribed by any Regulations for the time being in force under Sections 99 or 101 of the 1984 Act, for authorising the Council to sell or otherwise dispose of the vehicle if it had been left on a road and if it appeared to the Council that it had been abandoned.

Revocations

57. The Order specified in Schedule 21 to this Order is hereby revoked.
