The South Lanarkshire Council (On-Street Parking and Charges)

Consolidation Order 2005

South Lanarkshire Council in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by Section 19 of The Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Procedure) (Scotland) Regulations 1999, Sections 45, 46, 47, 49, 52 and 53 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984, as amended, ("the Act") and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Act and of all other enabling, hereby make the following order:-

Citation and Commencement

1. This Order may be cited as "The South Lanarkshire Council (On-street Parking and Charges) Consolidation Order 2005" and shall come into operation on the Seventh day of February Two Thousand and Five.

Interpretation

2 (i) In this Order, except where the context otherwise requires, the following expressions shall have the meanings hereby respectively assigned to them:-

"Council" means South Lanarkshire Council;

"Chief Constable" means the Chief Constable of Strathclyde Police;

"Controlled Parking Zone" means those areas within which parking bays are situated and whose use is controlled by an Order;

"vehicle" unless the context otherwise requires, means a vehicle of any description and includes a machine or implement of any kind drawn or propelled along roads whether or not by mechanical power;

"motor cycle" has the same meaning as is given to the expression in Regulation (3)(2) of the Road Vehicles (Construction and Use) Regulations 1986;

"parking attendant" means a person authorised by, or on behalf of, the Council to supervise any parking place;

"parking bay" means a space in a parking place which is provided for the leaving of a vehicle;

"ticket parking meter" means any apparatus designed to (a) accept payment by drivers, (b) indicate the time externally and (c) issue tickets indicating the payment of a charge, the period in respect of which has been paid and the day and time at which the charge was paid;

"parking places" means an area of road, which is bounded by the edge of the carriageway and which has a width of 2.4 metres or thereby, unless otherwise stated, and designated as a parking place in Article 3 to this Order;

"disabled person's badge" has the same meaning as in the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) (Scotland) Regulations 2002;

"disabled person's vehicle" has the same meaning as in The Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (Scotland) Regulations 2002;

"emergency service vehicle" means a vehicle being used by the Police, Fire Brigade or Ambulance Service;

"passenger vehicle" has the same meaning as is given to the expression in Regulation (3) (2) of the Road Vehicle (Construction and Use) Regulations 1986;

"permitted hours" means:-

- (i) in so far as it relates to the parking places detailed in Schedules 1 and 2, the period between 8.00am and 6.00pm, Monday to Saturday and 1.00pm and 6.00pm on a Sunday; or
- (ii) in so far as it relates to the parking places detailed in Schedule 3, the period between 8.00am and 6.00pm, Monday to Friday and 8.00am and 1.00pm on a Saturday

"registered keeper" is the person for the time being registered at the Driver and Vehicle Licensing Centre as the person recorded as keeping the vehicle and the person named on the Vehicle Registration Document. The registered keeper is not necessarily either the legal owner of the vehicle or the driver or user of the vehicle at the time being; "relevant position" has the same meaning as Section 4 of the Local Authorities Traffic Orders (Exemption for Disabled Persons) (Scotland) Regulations 1971;

"telecommunications apparatus" is as defined in the Telecommunications Act 1984.

"goods" includes postal packets of any description. Delivering and collecting, in relation to any goods, includes checking the goods for the purpose of their delivery or collection.

"goods vehicle" means a vehicle constructed or adapted for the use of the conveyance of goods or burden of any description but not including a dual-purpose vehicle;

"taxi" has the same meaning as in Section 23(1) of the Civic Government (Scotland) Act 1982;

"residents parking permit" or "permit" means a badge, disc or electronic identification device issued by the Council, in accordance with the provisions of this Order, to a person who ordinarily resides in a dwelling-house in the area that falls within the Controlled Parking Zone;

"initial charge" has the same meaning as in Section 46(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

(ii) Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended by any subsequent enactment.

PART II

PARKING PLACES

Designation of parking places

3. Each area on the road, which is described as a designated parking place in Schedules 1, 2 and 3 to this Order, is designated as a parking place for the purposes of this Order.

Layout and marking of parking places and parking bays

4. The number of parking bays in each parking place shall not exceed the number specified in Column 3 of Schedules 1, 2 and 3 to this Order in relation to that parking place and the number and situation of such parking bays in each parking place shall be as determined by the Council.

Marking on the carriageway of parking places and parking bays.

5. The limit of each parking bay and the limit of each parking place shall be indicated on the carriageway in such a manner as the Council may determine by lines or other indications.

Vehicle for which parking places are designated

Each parking place designated in Schedules 1, 2 and 3 to this Order may be used, subject to the provisions of this Order, for the leaving, during the permitted hours, of such vehicles as are passenger vehicles, motor cycles or disabled person's vehicles.

Amount of initial charge at parking places

7. The initial charge for a vehicle left in a parking place designated in Schedules 1, 2 and 3 to this Order, during the permitted hours, shall be in accordance with the rates in Schedule 4 having regard both to the location of the parking place and the period for which the vehicle is parked.

Amount of penalty charge at parking places

- 8. (i) If a vehicle is left parked in a parking place as designated in Schedules 1, 2 or 3 to this Order, during the permitted hours, for a period longer than the initial period for which payment was made by the initial charge an additional amount of sixty pounds (hereinafter referred to as the "penalty charge") shall be payable; and
 - (ii) In the case of a vehicle, in respect of which a penalty charge has been incurred, it shall be the duty of the parking attendant to fix to the vehicle, or give such to the person appearing to him to be in charge of the vehicle, a penalty charge notice, as specified in the Road Traffic Act 1991, Section 66.

Period for which a vehicle may be left after a penalty charge has been issued

- 9. (i) The period for which a vehicle shall be left in a parking place after a penalty charge has been incurred, shall not exceed five hours.
 - (ii) If a vehicle is left in a parking place for more than five hours after a penalty charge has been incurred, a further penalty charge shall be incurred for that parking place.

Restriction on the removal of notices

Where a penalty charge notice has been attached to a vehicle in accordance with the provisions of Article 8(ii) of this Order, no person, not being the driver of the vehicle or a person duly authorised by the Council, shall remove the notice from the vehicle unless authorised to do so by the driver.

Installation of parking ticket machines

11. For each parking place designated in Schedules 1, 2 and 3 to this Order there may be a parking ticket machine at or near each parking place.

Interval before vehicle may be left again

12. No vehicle which has been taken away from a parking bay in a parking place, after the initial charge has been incurred, shall until the expiration of one hour from the time it was taken away, again be left in that parking place during the permitted hours.

Alteration of position of vehicles in parking places

Where any vehicle is standing in a parking place in contravention of the provisions of Articles 19, 20 or 30 of this Order, a parking attendant or other person authorised by the Council may alter or cause to be altered the position of the vehicle in order that its position shall comply with those provisions.

Removal of vehicle from parking places

14. Where a parking attendant is of the opinion that any of the provisions contained in Articles 6, 9, 12, 16, 23 or 27 of this Order have been contravened or have not been complied with in respect of the vehicle left in a parking place, they may remove or cause to be removed the vehicle from the parking place and, where it is so removed shall provide for the safe custody of the vehicle.

Movement of vehicles in parking places in an emergency

Any person duly authorised by the council or police constable in uniform or parking attendant may move or cause to be moved, in case of an emergency, to a place they think fit, a vehicle left in a parking place.

Power to suspend parking places

16 (i) Any person duly authorised by the Council may suspend the use of a parking place or any part thereof whenever such suspension is considered reasonably necessary:-

- (a) for the purpose of facilitating the movement of traffic or promoting its safety; or
- (b) for the purpose of any building operation, demolition or excavation in or adjacent to the parking place or the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the parking place, or the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or adjacent to the parking place of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity, or of any telecommunications apparatus or traffic sign or parking ticket meter; or
- (c) for the convenience of occupiers of premises adjacent to the parking place on any occasion of the removal of furniture from one office or dwelling-house to another or the removal of furniture from such premises to a depository or to such premises from a depository; or
- (d) on any occasion on which it is likely, by reason of some special `attraction, that any street will be thronged or obstructed; or
- (e) for the convenience of occupiers of premises adjacent to the parking place at times of weddings or funerals, or on other special occasions;
- (ii) Any person suspending the use of a parking place, or any part thereof in accordance with the provisions of this Article, shall thereupon place or cause to be placed in or adjacent to any part of that parking place, the use of which is suspended, a traffic sign indicating that waiting is prohibited;
- (iii) No person shall cause or permit a vehicle to be left:-
 - (a) in a parking bay during such period, as there is in or adjacent to that bay, a traffic sign placed in pursuance of paragraph (ii) of this Article;
 - (b) in any part of any parking place not being a parking bay during such a period as there is in or adjacent to that part of the parking place a traffic sign placed in pursuance of paragraph (ii) of this Article, provided that nothing in this Article shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle being used for the fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes or any vehicle being used for any purpose specified in Article 18 (i) (b), (d), (f) and (g) of

this Order to be left in a parking place if that vehicle is left with the permission of the person suspending the use of the parking place, or part thereof, in pursuance of paragraph (i) of this Article, or a parking attendant.

Restriction of use of vehicles at parking places.

- 17 (i) No person shall use any vehicle, while it is in a parking place during the permitted hours, in connection with the sale of any article to any person in or near the parking place in connection with the selling or offering for sale of their skills in handy-craft or their services in any other capacity;
 - (ii) Provided that nothing in this Article shall prevent the sale of goods from a vehicle, if the vehicle is one which may be left in a parking place in accordance with Article 18 of this Order and the goods are immediately delivered at or taken into premises adjacent to the vehicle from which the sale is effected.

Restrictions on waiting of vehicle in parking places

- 18. (i) Without prejudice to the foregoing provisions of this Order with respect to vehicles which are left in a parking place in accordance with those provisions, any other vehicle may wait during the permitted hours anywhere in a parking place if:-
 - (a) the vehicle is waiting only for so long as is necessary to enable a person to board or alight from the vehicle; or
 - (b) a vehicle is waiting owing to the driver being prevented from proceeding by circumstances beyond the driver's control or such waiting being necessary in order to avoid an accident; or
 - (c) the vehicle is used for fire brigade purposes or is an ambulance or a vehicle other than a passenger vehicle in the service of a local authority or police force, in either case being used in pursuance of statutory powers or duties.; or
 - (d) the vehicle is waiting only for so long as is necessary to enable it to be used in connection with the removal of obstruction to traffic; or

- (e) the vehicle, not being a passenger vehicle, is waiting for so long as may be reasonably necessary to enable it to be used for any purpose specified in Article 16(i)(b) or (e) of this Order; or
- (f) the vehicle is in the service of, or employ of, a universal postal service provider and is waiting while postal packets addressed to premises adjacent to the parking place are being unloaded from the vehicle or having been unloaded therefrom are being delivered or while postal packets are being collected from premises or posting boxes adjacent to the parking place in which the vehicle is waiting; or
- (g) the vehicle is in actual use in connection with the removal of furniture from one office or dwelling-house to another or the removal of furniture from such premises to a depository or such premises from a depository.
- (ii) No charge specified in the foregoing provisions of this Order shall be payable in respect of any vehicle waiting in a parking place in accordance with the foregoing provisions of this Article.
- (iii) Except as provided in the foregoing provisions of this Article, the driver of a vehicle shall not cause or permit a vehicle to wait in a parking place during the permitted hours.
- (iv) Nothing in the forgoing provisions of this Article shall be taken as authorising anything which would be a contravention of any Regulations made or having effect as if made under Section 25 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

Manner of waiting in parking places.

A person causing or permitting a vehicle to wait in a parking place by virtue of Article 18 (i)(e), (f) or (g) shall take all such steps as are necessary to ensure that the longitudinal axis of the vehicle is parallel to the edge of the carriageway nearest to the vehicle and the distance between the said edge and the nearest wheel of the vehicle is not more than 300mm.

Manner of standing in parking places

- Every vehicle left in a parking place shall so stand such that no bay is occupied by more than one vehicle and that every part of the vehicle is within the limits of a parking bay; provided that, where the length of any vehicle precludes compliance with this paragraph, such a vehicle shall be deemed to be within the limits of the parking bay if:-
 - (i) the extreme front of the vehicle portion, or as the case may be, the extreme rear portion on the vehicle is within 300mm of an indication on the carriageway provided under Article 5 of this Order in relation to the parking bay; or
 - (ii) the vehicle or any part thereof, is not within the limits of any adjoining parking bay.

Exemption from charges

- 21. (i) A vehicle left during the permitted hours in a parking bay by the driver thereof, which is driven by or carrying a disabled person and which displays in the relevant position a valid disabled person's badge issued by a local authority, in exercise of its powers under Section 21 (1) of the Chronically Sick and Disabled Persons Act 1970 shall be exempt from the charges specified in this Order;
 - (ii) A vehicle left during the permitted hours in a parking bay by the driver thereof, which is displaying a valid residents parking permit issued by the Council in accordance with Part VI of this Order shall be exempt from the charges specified in Schedule 4 to this Order.

Power to dispose of abandoned vehicles

22 (i) The Council may, in respect of a vehicle which has been removed from a parking place in pursuance of Article 14 of this Order, if it appears to them to have been abandoned, sell or otherwise dispose of the vehicle after having made reasonable enquiry to ascertain the name and address of the owner of the vehicle.

(iii) The Council shall be deemed not to have made reasonable enquiry to ascertain the name and address of the owner of any vehicle to which this Article applies unless they have taken, in relation to that vehicle, such steps that may be prescribed by any Regulation for the time being in force under Section 99 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, for authorising the Council to sell or otherwise dispose of the vehicle if it had been left on a road and if it appeared to the Council that it had been abandoned.

PART III

PARKING PLACES WITH PARKING TICKET MACHINES

Method of payment of initial charge

- 23 (i) The initial charge as specified in Schedule 4 to this Order, where it relates to Schedules 1, 2 and 3, as detailed in column 1 of Schedule 4, shall be payable on the leaving of the vehicle in the parking place by the insertion in a parking ticket machine relating to the parking bay in which the vehicle is left of:-
 - (a) a coin, or more than one coin, inserted immediately one after the other, of a denomination or denominations accepted by the parking ticket machine; or
 - (b) an electronic smart card of a type designated for such use by the Council and;
 - (ii) the ticket, issued by the parking ticket machine at the time of payment, shall be so exhibited on the vehicle, in a conspicuous position facing forwards on the inside glass of the windscreen such that the time and other details indicated on the front thereof are clearly visible to a person standing at the front nearside of the vehicle;
 - (iii) a ticket shall be valid for a single stay only and no other ticket issued by a parking ticket machine shall be displayed;

Indication by parking tickets

Payment of the initial charge for a vehicle left in a parking place shall be indicated by the issue from a parking ticket machine at or near the parking place of a numbered ticket indicating the issuing machine's identity, what charge has been paid and the date and time of the payment, or what charge has been paid and the date and time of departure, and by the exhibition of the ticket in accordance with the provisions of paragraph (ii) of the last preceding Article;

(ii) The expiry of the period for which the initial charge has been paid shall be indicated when there is exhibited on the vehicle a ticket issued by a parking ticket machine relating to the parking bay in which the vehicle is left by the expiry time in respect of the period for which payment has been made and where the time shown on the clock of the parking ticket machine is later than the expiry time shown on the ticket.

No ticket or meter feeding

- 25 (i) If during the permitted hours a vehicle is left in a parking place and no parking ticket is exhibited on that vehicle in accordance with the provisions of Article 23, a penalty charge shall be payable.
 - (ii) If, during the permitted hours a vehicle, which has complied with the provisions of Article 23 (ii) and the period for which the initial charge was paid has expired, thereafter displays a further parking ticket, in contravention of Article 23 (iii), a penalty charge shall be payable.

PART IV

PARKING PLACES FOR DISABLED PERSONS VEHILCES

Vehicles for which parking places are designated

Each parking place designated in Schedules 1, 2 and 3 of this Order may be used without payment, subject to the provisions of this Order, for the leaving, during the permitted hours of a vehicle which is driven by or carrying a disabled person and which displays in the relevant position a valid disabled persons badge.

Parking bays for the use of disabled only

Only a vehicle which is driven by or carrying a disabled person and which displays in the relevant position a valid disabled persons badge, shall park in a parking bay marked in accordance with diagram 661A of The Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002;

Penalty for misuse of disabled persons parking bay

Any vehicle parked in contravention to the last proceeding Article shall be subject to a penalty charge.

Period for which a vehicle may be left

A disabled person's vehicle, displaying a valid disabled persons badge, may park without limit of time during the permitted hours in the parking places detailed in Schedules 1, 2 and 3 to this Order.

PART V

PARKING PLACES FOR MOTOR CYCLES

Manner of standing in motor cycle parking places

A motor cycle, with or without a side car, shall wait only in a parking place described in Schedules 1, 2 or 3 to this Order and indicated in such a manner as the Council may determine by signs or carriageway markings indicating the use by a motor cycle with or without a side car only, such that it is parked wholly within the limits of that parking bay.

Vehicles for which parking places are designated.

Each parking place designated in Schedules 1, 2 and 3 to this Order and indicated by signs or markings for the use by motor cycle(s) may be used without payment, subject to the provisions of this Order.

Period for which a motor cycle may be left

32 The period for which a motor cycle may be left in a parking place designated in Schedules 1, 2 or 3 to this Order during the permitted hours shall not exceed 3 hours.

PART VI

RESIDENTS PARKING AND CHARGES

Maintain residents parking permits

This Order shall maintain the issue of residents parking permits, introduced in a previous Order and now revoked, at such charges as detailed in Schedule 5 to this Order and on such terms and conditions as described in Articles 34 to 42 of this Order to any person who ordinarily resides in a dwelling-house in the lengths of road covered by Schedules 1, 2 or 3 to this Order.

Controlled Parking Zone

The Controlled Parking Zones, may be divided into residents sub-zones as defined in Schedule 6, which details each Controlled Parking Zone and the lengths of road contained in each of the residents sub-zones.

Displaying permit

The residents parking permit shall be displayed on the nearside of the vehicle, behind the glass of the windscreen, in such a position as to ensure that the front side of the permit is clearly visible to any person standing at the front or nearside of the vehicle.

Conditions for parking with a permit displayed

Any vehicle which displays a valid residents parking permit in the manner specified in Article 35 to this Order shall be permitted to park without incurring charges and without limit of time, in a parking bay within the residents sub-zone for which the permit is valid.

Issue of residents parking permits

- 37 As regard to the issue of residents parking permits
 - (i) any owner or occupier who is resident in a road specified in Schedule 7 to this Order may apply to the Council for the issue of a residents parking permit allowing a vehicle to be left in a parking bay within the residents sub-zone as defined in Schedule 7. Such applications shall be made in a manner determined by the Council and the applicant shall provide such information as the Council require in order to verify that the issue of a permit will be valid; and
 - (ii) the Council, on being satisfied that the applicant has provided the information required in paragraph (i) of this Article, shall issue to the applicant on payment of the sum detailed in Schedule 6 to this Order, a permit as referred to in this Article and as described in Article 38 and to be used as defined in Articles 34 and 35 to this Order; and
 - (iii) the Council shall issue such permits for each sub-zone as it determines taking into account the number of parking bays available, the number of residents requesting parking permits, the availability of off-street private parking space for the use of the applicant and any other factors which from time to time may be applicable in any of the sub-zones detailed in Schedule 7 to this Order.

Permit identification

38. A valid parking permit shall include any identification mark specified by the Council, an indication of the resident's sub-zone to which that permit relates and a date on which, the day after, the permit ceases to become valid.

Surrender of permit

39. A residents parking permit holder as defined in Article 37 of this Order, may surrender a permit to the Council at any time and shall receive a refund for the unused completed months on a pro rata basis, less an administrative charge as specified in Schedule 6 to this Order.

Withdrawal of permit

- 40. The Council may, by giving 28 day's notice in writing, serve on the permit holder at the address shown on the application for the permit, or such other address believed to be the permit holder's residence at the time, a notice withdrawing the permit if:-
 - (i) the resident parking permit holder ceases to be a resident at the address for which the permit is issued upon which the appropriate refund as referred to in Article 39 to this Order shall be made by the Council to the permit holder; or
 - (ii) the council issues a duplicate or replacement permit under the provisions of Article 41 to this Order.

Duplicate or replacement permit

- 41. A duplicate or replacement permit may be issued, on application, if:-
 - (i) a permit that is mutilated or defaced or faded so that the identifying mark, as referred to in Article 38 to this Order, is illegible, whereby the permit holder shall surrender the permit to the Council and shall apply for the issue under paragraph (i) of Article 37 to this Order for a duplicate or replacement permit which, when issued on the payment of an administration charge as specified in Schedule 6 to this Order, shall render the original permit invalid; and
 - (ii) a permit is lost or destroyed, whereby the permit holder may apply to the Council for the issue of a duplicate or replacement permit under paragraph
 (i) of Article 37 to this Order and paragraph (i) of this Article; or
 - (iii) a permit holder ceases to be the owner of the vehicle for which the permit was originally issued, then the permit holder shall surrender the permit and may apply for the issue under paragraph (i) of Article 37 to this Order of a replacement permit in respect of any new vehicle at no further charge, such replacement permit rendering the original permit invalid.

Provision of duplicate or replacement permit

42. The provisions of Part VI to this order shall apply equally to duplicate or replacement permits as an original permit.

Revocation of existing orders

The Orders, or parts thereof, specified in Schedule 7 to this Order are hereby revoked.
